Lease of Crown Land.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Government Agent of the Western Province will receive tenders for the purchase of the lease of the under-mentioned Crown land for a period of two years and seven months from March 1, 1940, subject to the under mentioned conditions.

2. The tenders which must be in sealed envelopes and superscribed "Tender for Lease of lot 893 in P.P. No. 14,349" will be received at the Colombo Kachcheri until 11 A.M. on Friday, February 16, 1940, when they will be opened. All persons making the tenders will be required to be present or to satisfy the Government Agent by some duly accredited agent that the tender is made *bona fide*.

Conditions.

1. The highest tenderer shall be declared the purchaser.
2. A sum equal to six months' rent shall be paid in cash as security on the day of sale, and the rent shall be paid by the lessee, in equal quarterly instalments in advance. The security will be credited to revenue and accounted for at the termination of the lease.
3. The purchaser is only entitled to cultivate the land and take the produce of the land provided that no permanent cultivation shall be grown in the land.
4. The purchaser or his workmen shall not cut down any trees or interfere with any existing fence or boundary.
5. The purchaser shall be bound to fence the land leased to him, if called upon by the Government Agent to do so.
6. The purchaser shall keep the land clean and in good order, pay all rates and taxes, and comply with Municipal Council regulations.
7. The Government Agent or any one acting under his authority will be entitled to re-enter into occupation at any time on giving three months' notice to the lessee without compensation.

8. The purchaser shall not assign, transfer, or sublet the land without the written permission from the Government Agent, Western Province, to do so.

9. No milch-cows, she-buffaloes, goats, pigs, &c., shall be permitted to graze on the land, and such animals found grazing thereon shall be liable to seizure by the Government Agent or any person authorized by him. The permit-holder shall allow the Municipal Council officers direct control to enforce this prohibition.

10. If the whole or any portion of the land is required by the Government before the expiry of the lease, such land or portion shall be surrendered on a months' notice being given; a proportionate reduction in the rental will be made for the unexpired period of the lease respecting the land or portion thereof resumed by the Crown for which rent has previously been paid.

11. Putting up structures of any sort or the running of tea booths on the land without the permission of the Government Agent previously obtained in writing is strictly prohibited.

12. In the event of any breach of the foregoing conditions the Government Agent shall have the power to resume possession of the land and eject the purchaser and his workmen from the land without compensation.

13. The Government Agent reserves the right to reject any tender or all tenders.

Lease of Crown Rubber Lands.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Government Agent of the Province of Sabaragamuwa, will receive sealed tenders for the right to take for the year ending December 31, 1940, the produce of the rubber trees in the under-mentioned Crown rubber lands which have been duly registered under the Rubber Control Ordinance.

2. The tenders which must be enclosed in sealed envelopes superscribed "Tender for the Right to take the Produce of Rubber Trees" will be received at the Ratnapura Kacheheri until 10 A.M., on February 1, 1940, when they will be opened and all persons making tenders will be required to be present or satisfy the Government Agent, Province of Sabaragamuwa, by some duly accredited agent or agents that the tender is *bona fide*.

3. The person whose tender is accepted by the Government Agent will be required to deposit the full amount of his tender at once in cash and obtain the necessary lease.

4. Tenders must be made for each land separately.

5. The lessee shall further undertake to keep the land free of jungle growth.

6. The lessee shall wherever necessary take adequate measures to prevent silting of the adjoining land or stream by means of silt traps, contour drains or otherwise.

7. At the expiration or sooner determination of the lease, the lessee shall yield quiet possession of the land to any person acting under the orders of the Government Agent.

8. The extent given is only approximate and if the actual total extent of the land should hereafter be found to be less than the extent set forth below, no claim for refund or rebate on account of shortage in extent will be considered unless the variation exceeds 10 per cent. of the stated extent.

9. All particulars regarding issue of coupons should be obtained from the Rubber Controller, Colombo.
