Customs Notification (Tariff) No. 40/2.

THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE.

IT is hereby notified that the following resolution under section 9 of the Customs Ordinance passed by the State Council at its public session on December 1, 1939, and sanctioned by the Governor has been submitted to and sanctioned by the Secretary of State for the Colonies.

· RESOLUTION.

This Council resolves under section 9 of the Customs Ordinance (Chapter 185) that, with effect from the date on which the sanction of the Secretary of State to this resolution is notified in the Government Gazette, import duty shall be levied and paid upon the goods severally specified in column I. of the Schedule to this resolution at the General rates prescribed in column III. of the aforesaid Schedule.

Provided that import duty at the preferential rate, if any, prescribed in column II. of that Schedule shall be levied and paid on such of the aforesaid goods as may be proved to the satisfaction of the Collector of Customs to have been produced or manufactured in, and to have been consigned from, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the Dominions, India, Burma, the territories administered by His Majesty's Governments in the Dominions under Mandate or otherwise, the British Colonies, the British Frotectorates and Protected States, and the Mandated Territories of Tanganyika, the Cameroons under British Mandate and Togoland under British Mandate.
