THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACT, 1939.

DEFENCE Regulation made by the Governor by virtue of the powers vested in him by section 1 of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Act, 1939, of the Imperial Parliament, as adapted, modified and extended to Ceylon by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939.

REGULATION.

The Defence (Control of Exports) Regulations, as amended by the Regulation published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 8,566 of January 9, 1940, are hereby further amended as follows:—

(1) in regulation 3 thereof, by the substitution for the words "by the Controller.", of the following:—
"by the Controller:

Provided that nothing in this regulation shall be deemed to apply to the taking of any such commodity on board any ship, in such quantities as the Principal Collector of Customs may consider reasonable in the circumstances of each case, and in accordance with any written law applicable to each such case—

(i) by or on behalf of the master of the ship, for use as ship's stores on that ship;

(ii) by any resident leaving Ceylon, or any passenger passing through Ceylon, on that ship, for the personal use of such resident or passenger or the members of his family;

(iii) by any person licensed to trade within the harbour, for the purpose of such trade."

- (2) in the Schedule thereto, by the addition of the following new items:-
 - (8) Plumbago. (9) Cacao.

 - (10) Coconut shell, including charcoal.
 (11) Hides and Skins, raw or salted.
 (12) Kapok.
 (13) Arecanuts.

 - (14) Cardamoms.
 - Cinnamon Quills. Cinnamon Chips.
 - Cloves.

 - (17) Cloves.
 (18) Dry Ginger.
 (19) Mace.
 (20) Nutmegs.
 (21) Pepper, whole.
 (22) Vanilla.
 (23) Other Spices.
 (24) Coir fibre (bristle and mattress).
