THE REVENUE PROTECTION ORDINANCE.

Order under Section 2.

WHEREAS I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, have during the present session of the State Council approved of the introduction into the State Council of a resolution whereby, if such resolution be carried, the import duty payable on the goods specified in column I. of the schedule hereto shall be altered :

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by section 2 of the Revenue Protection Ordinance (Chapter 191), I do hereby order the Principal Collector of Customs from midnight of the seventeenth/eighteenth day of July, 1940, to demand and to levy on the goods specified in column I. of the schedule hereto, the import duty set out in column II. of that schedule in lieu of the import duty payable thereon under the existing law.
