THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF IMPORTS) REGULATIONS.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulation 3 of the Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Order amend the Schedule to the Order under that regulation published at page 1917 of *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 8,543 of November 1, 1939 (and last amended by the Order published in *Gazette* No. 8,628 of June 28, 1940), as follows:—

- (1) by the omission of item 2;
- (2) by the omission, from item 4, of the word "revolvers".

THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF IMPORTS) REGULATIONS.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulation 3 of the Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Order amend the Order under that regulation published at page 1918 of *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 8,543 of November 1, 1939 (and last amended by the Order published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 8,609 of April 30, 1940), as follows:—

- (1) in paragraph (1) of that Order, by the substitution for the words "of any of the goods specified in the First Schedule hereto from any territory", of the words "of such goods, of any class or description specified in the First Schedule hereto, as are grown, produced or manufactured in any territory";

(2) in the First Schedule to that Order, by the insertion of the following new items in the appropriate places:—

- " 99A. Gold leaf.
- 166A. Revolvers."

(3) in the Second Schedule to that Order, by the substitution for item 1 thereof, of the following new item:—

" 1. Any territory or place not forming part of the British Empire and not being enemy territory within the meaning of the Defence (Trading with the Enemy) Regulations, 1939."

THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF IMPORTS) REGULATIONS.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulation 4 of the Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Order amend the Order under that regulation published at page 1919 of *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 8,543 of November 1, 1939, as follows:—

- (1) in paragraph (1) of that Order, by the substitution for the words "the goods specified in the First Schedule hereto shall not be imported into Ceylon from any territory", of the words "no person shall import into Ceylon such goods, of any class or description specified in the First Schedule hereto, as are grown, produced or manufactured in any territory";
- (2) in the Second Schedule to that Order, by the substitution, for item 1 thereof, of the following new item:—

" 1. Any territory or place not forming part of the British Empire and not being enemy territory within the meaning of the Defence (Trading with the Enemy) Regulations, 1939."
