THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACT, 1939.

DEFENCE Regulation made by the Governor by virtue of the powers vested in him by section 1 of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Act, 1939, of the Imperial Parliament, as adapted, modified and extended to Ceylon by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939.

The Defence (Securities) Regulations, published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 8,596 of March 28, 1940, are hereby amended by the insertion, immediately after regulation 3, of the following new regulation:—

Interpretation.

3A. For the purposes of these regulations, "owner", in relation to any security, includes any person who has power to sell or transfer the security, or who has the custody thereof, or who receives, whether on his own behalf or on behalf of any other person, dividends or interest thereon, or who has any other right or interest therein.

THE REVENUE PROTECTION ORDINANCE.

Order under Section 2.

Whereas I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, have during the present session of the State Council approved of the introduction into the State Council of a resolution whereby, if such resolution be carried, the import duty payable on the goods specified in column I. of the schedule hereto shall be altered:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by section 2 of the Revenue Protection Ordinance (Chapter 191), I do hereby order the Principal Collector of Customs from midnight of the twentythird/twentyfourth day of July, 1940, to demand and to levy on the goods specified in column I. of the schedule hereto, the import duty set out in column II. of that schedule in lieu of the import duty payable thereon under the existing law.
