THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACT, 1939.

DEFENCE regulation made by the Governor by virtue of the powers vested in him by section 1 of the Emergency Powers (Defence) Act, 1939, of the Imperial Parliament, as adapted, modified, and extended to Ceylon by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939.

REGULATION.

The Defence (Trading with the Enemy) Regulations, 1939, are hereby amended in regulation 18 (1) thereof, by the substitution in the definition of "enemy territory", for the words "with His Majesty;", of the words "with His Majesty, and also any area which the Governor may by Order direct to be treated for the purposes of these regulations as enemy territory;".
