GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS.

THE DEFENCE (FINANCE NO. 3) REGULATIONS.

Order.

IN pursuance of the provisions of regulation 1 of the Defence (Finance No. 3) Regulations, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Order grant exemption from that regulation in respect of every bank note to which the said Regulations apply, where such bank note

(a) is imported or brought into Ceylon from British India;
(b) is brought into Ceylon by a passenger disembarking at any place in Ceylon, if, but only if, the value of the note or the aggregate value of the notes so brought by the passenger does not exceed such amount as the Controller of Exchange may, in the circumstances of the case, consider reasonable for the personal expenses of the passenger;
(c) is brought by, or for the use of, any member of His Majesty's Regular Naval, Military and Air Forces in Ceylon.
