THE DEFENCE (MISCELLANEOUS) REGULATIONS.

ORDER made by the Governor by virtue of the powers vested in him by regulation 23A of the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations.

ORDER.

The Order under Regulation 23A of the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations, published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 8,648 of August 3, 1940, is hereby amended by the addition of the following proviso thereto :—

“ Provided that a permit to depart from Ceylon to a destination outside Ceylon shall not be necessary in the case of any such European who, being a visitor to Ceylon or a passenger in transit through Ceylon, is in possession of an exit pass—

- (i.) issued to him or endorsed on his passport, in such form and by such officer as may be approved by the Chief Secretary ; and
- (ii.) bearing a date not earlier than one month prior to the date of his departure.”
