Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulation 3 of the Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Order amend the Order under that regulation published at page 1918 of *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 8,543 of November 1, 1939, as follows :—

- (1) in the First Schedule thereto, by the substitution, for item 109, of the following new item :—
“ 109. Cutlery other than razor blades.”;
- (2) by the substitution, for the Second Schedule thereto, of the following new Schedule :—

- (1) in the First Schedule thereto, by the insertion, immediately after item 25—B, of the following new item :—
“ 25—c. Cutlery : razor blades.”

(2) by the substitution, for the Second Schedule thereto, of the following new Schedule —
