An Ordinance to extend the operation of section 2 (1) of the Galle Municipal Council (Differential Rates) Ordinance,

No. 31 of 1938.

A. CALDECOTT.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Galle Municipal Council (Differential Rates) (Extension) Ordinance, No. 4 of 1943, and shall be deemed for all purposes to have come into operation on the first day of January, 1943.

Short title and date of operation.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (2) of section 2 of the Galle Municipal Council (Differential Rates) Ordinance, No. 31 of 1938, sub-section (1) of that section shall continue in operation until the thirty-first day of December, 1943.

Continuation of the operation of section 2 (1) of Ordinance No. 31 of 1938.

Passed in Council the Twenty-fifth day of March, One thousand Nine hundred and Forty-three.
