# DRAFT ORDINANCES.

## MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:-

## An Ordinance to amend section 17 of the Defence Force Ordinance.

Cap. 258.

Short title.

Chapter 258.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Defence Force

Amendment Ordinance No. of 1943. Section 17 of the Defence Force Ordinance is hereby

Amendment of section 17 of

amended, by the addition at the end of that section, of the following new sub-section :-

"(3) In this section, "family" means any dependent child or children, whether legitimate or illegitimate, and in relation to any officer or soldier who leaves no widow or dependent child, includes any dependent parent, brother or sister of such officer or soldier."

# Objects and Reasons.

Section 17 of the Defence Force Ordinance, inter alia, authorises the award of a pension or gratuity to the widow and "family" of an officer or soldier. In the absence of a definition of the word "family", the section does not enable an award to be made to a dependent parent, brother or sister of an unmarried member of the Defence Force. The object of this Bill is to insert in section 17 a definition of the word "family" in order to enable pensions or gratuities to be paid in cases where an officer or soldier leaves no widow or dependent children.

The conditions and circumstances in which a pension or gratuity may be so awarded will be determined by the Governor under sub-section (2) of section 17.
