1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Housing and Town Improvement Amendment Ordinance, No. 17 of 1943. Short title.

Insertion of new section 80A in Chapter 199.

Power of local authority to undertake works at request of owners of dwelling houses and recover expenses.

2. The following new section is hereby inserted immediately after section 80 of the Housing and Town Improvement Ordinance (Chapter 199) and shall have effect as section 80A of that Ordinance:—

80A. (1) At the written request of the owner of any dwelling-house in respect of which a closing order has been made under this Chapter, the local authority may, if it deems fit, and under such conditions as it may determine, cause all or any of such works as may be required to render such dwelling-house fit for human habitation, to be executed by contract or otherwise

(2) The expenses incurred by the local authority in the execution of any work in pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1), together with such amount as may be fixed by the local authority as commission for surveys, plans, superintendence and other services of officers or servants in the employment of the local authority, shall be recoverable in the same manner and by the same process as a rate.
