BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Councils (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 16 of 1943.

2. Section 43 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance is hereby amended in sub-section (1) of that section as follows:--

(a) by the insertion, immediately after paragraph (h) of that sub-section, of the following :-

" Dairies.

(hh) establishment and maintenance of municipal dairies; "; and

(b) by the insertion, immediately after paragraph (n) of that sub-section, of the following:-

" Public services.

(nn) establishment and maintenance any form of public service which the Council may be specially authorised by the Executive Committee of Local Administration to establish, maintain or provide;"

> Power of local authority to undertake works at request of owners of dwelling and recover expenses.

The following new section is hereby inserted immediately after section 80 of the Housing and Town Improvement Ordinance (Chapter 199) and shall have effect as section SOA of that Ordinance:-

80a. (1) At the written request of the owner of any dwelling-house in respect of which a closing order has been made under this Chapter, the local authority may, if it deems fit, and under such conditions as it may determine, cause all or any of such works as may be required to render such dwelling-house fit for human habitation, to be executed by contract or otherwise

(2) The expenses incurred by the local authority in the execution of any work in pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1), together with such amount as may be fixed by the local authority as commission for surveys, plans, superintendence and other services of officers or servants in the employment of the local authority, shall be recoverable in the same manner and by the same process as a rate.
