Notification of Land Kachcheri to Select persons to receive Permits—(Middle Class Ceylonese).

NOTICE is hereby given that the Government Agent, Northern Province, will hold a Land Kachcheri under the Land Development Ordinance (Cap. 320), at 10 A.M. on Saturday, March 13, 1943, at the Kilinochchi Circuit Bungalow to consider applications for lands particulars of which are given below and to select persons to receive permits for portions thereof according to their ability to cultivate.

2. The allotment will be confined to Middle Class Ceylonese.

3. All applications must reach the Government Agent, Northern Province, at the Jaffna Kachcheri, on or before March 5, 1943.

4. Every applicant should attend the Land Kachcheri in person or depute someone to represent him. If neither the applicant nor any person deputed to represent him attends the Land Kachcheri, the Government Agent, Northern Province, may presume that the applicant does not wish to pursue the application further.

5. Every applicant selected will be exempted from annual payment for a period of three years.

6. Inquiries with regard the Land Kachcheri should be addressed to the Government Agent, Northern Province.

7. Every selected applicant should pay at the Land Kachcheri a sum of rupees three per acre or part of an acre. MISCELLANEOUS LAND NOTICES.

Tenders for Mining Plumbago in Forest Reserves, Galle District.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Government Agent, Southern Province, Galle, will receive sealed tenders for mining plumbago for a period of one year, subject to the following conditions in Uragaha Forest Reserve, described in the Schedule hereto.

2. Tenders which must be enclosed in sealed envelopes super-scribed "Tender for Mining Plumbago" will be received at the Galle Kachcheri till 11 A.M. on Saturday, February 27, 1943, when they will be opened. All persons making tenders will be required to be present in person or satisfy the Government Agent by some duly accredited agent or agents that the tender is made in good faith. Separate tenders should be made for each block.

3. The person whose tender is accepted shall pay to the Conservator of Forests, Vajira road, Bambalapitiya, the full amount tendered and sign the mining permit and deed of indemnity for the due fulfilment of the conditions on which the tender is accepted. Should such person fail either to pay the sum of money or sign the mining permit his tender shall be cancelled.

4. On payment to the Conservator of Forests of the tendered amount in full, the successful tenderer will be permitted to enter the

land and will receive a mining permit entitling him to mine for plumbago, subject to the following conditions, *inter alia* —

- (a) The period of the permit shall be one year, but may be renewed with the permission of the Conservator of Forests if the latter is satisfied that the conditions of the permit have been fully complied with, for the duration of the war.
- (b) The permit holder shall not cut down or injure any trees on the land without first obtaining the permission in writing of the Divisional Forest Officer, and paying the value of such timber.
- (c) The permit holder shall allow the Conservator of Forests, the Government Agent, the Government Mineralogist, or the Divisional Forest Officer, or any person appointed in writing by any one of them to enter into the land for the purpose of inspecting the land, or any works thereon.
- (d) The permit holder shall not remove any plumbago from the said land except on a permit issued by the Divisional Forest Officer or otherwise than in accordance with the conditions of such permit.
- (e) The permit holder shall not, without the written authority of the Divisional Forest Officer, previously obtained, work or remove any minerals other than plumbago from the land.

- (f) The permit holder shall, before being permitted to enter the land, deposit with the Conservator of Forests a sum of Rs. 150 as security for the fulfilment of the conditions of the permit.
- (g) The permit holder shall pay to the Conservator of Forests —
 - (i) A sum calculated at the rate of 5 per cent. of the estimated value of plumbago put out from the land, which sum shall be paid monthly, or
 - (ii) A sum of Rs. 100 per annum per acre or part of an acre whichever amount is greater.

Further particulars can be obtained from the Conservator of Forests.
