LAND DEVELOPMENT NOTICES.

Notification of Land Kachcheri to select Persons to receive Permits—(Middle-Class).

NOTICE is hereby given that the Assistant Government Agent, Kalutara, will hold one or more Land Kachcheries under the Land Development Ordinance at the places and dates to be notified later to consider applications for the lands, particulars of which are given below and to select persons to receive permits for portions thereof.

2. A communication in writing, notifying the exact date and time of the Land Kachcheri at which applications will be considered will be sent to each applicant. Every applicant so notified should attend the Land Kachcheri in person or depute someone to represent him. If neither the applicant nor any person deputed to represent him attends the Land Kachcheri the Assistant Government Agent, may presume that the applicant does not wish to pursue his application further.

3. Allotments will be confined to Middle-Class Ceylonese.

4. Applications shall be in form L. C. 44, obtainable at any Kachcheri and, should reach the Assistant Government Agent, Kalutara, on or before April 15, 1943.

5. Every applicant who is selected to receive an allotment shall, within one week of his being told that he has been selected to receive a permit deposit with the Assistant Government Agent, a sum calculated at Rs. 3 per acre of the extent allotted. The deposit will not be refunded if, owing to any act or omission of the applicant, Government is put to the expense of an unnecessary survey. The decision of the Land Commissioner, whether such deposit may in any particular case be refunded or not, shall be final.

6. Where an applicant fails to pay the deposit required by paragraph 5, the allotment made to him will be cancelled.

7. All the lands appearing in the notice and described as doniyas are believed to be suitable for cultivation of paddy; all other lands are believed to be suitable for the cultivation of rubber, coconut, cinnamon, jak, arecanut, coffee, pineapple, cashew and all varieties of citrus.

4. On his signing the mining permit and the deed of indemnity for the due fulfilment of the conditions on which the tender is accepted, the successful tenderer will be permitted by the Conservator of Forests to enter the land and mine for plumbago therein, subject to the following conditions, *inter alia* :—

- (a) The period of the permit shall be one year but may be renewed with the permission of the Conservator of Forests if the latter is satisfied that the conditions of the permit have been duly complied with, for the duration of the war.
- (b) The permit-holder shall not cut down or injure any trees on the land without first obtaining the permission in writing of the Divisional Forest Officer and paying the value of such timber.
- (c) The permit-holder shall allow the Conservator, the Assistant Government Agent, Kalutara, the Government Mineralogist, or the Divisional Forest Officer, or any person appointed in writing by any of them to enter into the land for the purpose of inspecting the land or any works thereon.
- (d) The permit-holder shall not remove any plumbago from the said land except on a permit issued by the Divisional Forest Officer or otherwise than in accordance with the conditions of such permit.
- (e) The permit-holder shall not, without the written authority of the Divisional Forest Officer, previously obtained, work or remove any minerals other than plumbago from the land.
- (f) The permit-holder shall before being permitted to enter the land deposit with the Conservator of Forests, a sum of Rs. 150, as security for the fulfilment of the conditions of the permit.

(g) The permit-holder shall pay to the Conservator of Forests—

- (i.) A sum calculated at the rate of 5 per cent. of the estimated value of plumbago put out from the land which sum shall be paid monthly, or
- (ii.) a sum of Rs. 100 per annum per acre or part of an acre, whichever amount is greater.
