## MISCELLANEOUS LAND NOTICES.

## Lease of Crown Tea Lands.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Assistant Government Agent, Nuwara Ehiya, will receive sealed tenders for the right to take for the period from April 1, 1943, to March 31, 1944, the produce of the tea bushes standing in the under-mentioned lots 1-21 in Preliminary Plan No. A 803 adjoining Oliphant Estate, which has been duly registered under the Tea Control Ordinance.

2. The tenders which must be enclosed in sealed envelopes superscribed "Tender for the Right to take the produce of Tea Bushes" will be received at the Nuwara Ehiya Kachcheri until 11 A.M. on April 17, 1943, when they will be opened and all persons making tenders will be required to be present or satisfy the Assistant Government Agent, Nuwara Ehiya, by some duly accredited agent or agents that the tender is *bona fide*.

3. The tender shall specify the annual rental the person offering the tender is prepared to pay in respect of the lease. Provided that the minimum rental offered shall be Rs. 3,000 per year.

4. The person whose tender is accepted by the Assistant Government Agent will be required to deposit the full amount of tender at once in cash and obtain the necessary lease.

5. The lessee shall further undertake to keep the land free of jungle growth.

6. The lessee shall wherever necessary take adequate measures to prevent silting of the adjoining land or streams by means of silt traps, contour drains or otherwise.

7. At the expiration or sooner determination of the lease, the lessee shall yield quiet possession of the land to any person acting under the orders of the Assistant Government Agent.

8. All particulars regarding the issue of coupons should be obtained from the Tea Controller, Colombo.

9. Further particulars can be obtained from the Assistant Government Agent, Nuwara Ehiya.
