MISCELLANEOUS LAND NOTICES.

TENDERS are hereby invited for the purchase of about 315 young self-grown rubber plants, 6 months to 8 years old, from Crown land called Godaporahena at Warakagoda and depicted as lots 7, 10 and 17 in P. P. A. 853.

2. Tenders should be in sealed envelopes and marked "Tender for the purchase of young rubber plants" and should be sent to reach the Assistant Government Agent, Kalutara, not later than 12 noon on April 30, 1943, when they will be opened. All persons making tenders will be required to be present or to satisfy the Assistant Government Agent by some duly accredited agent that the tender is made *bona fide*.

3. Tenders should tender quotations for every 100 trees.
4. The Assistant Government Agent reserves the right to reject any or all tenders.
5. The successful tenderer would be called upon to deposit the full value for 315 plants at the rate quoted by him.
6. The successful tenderer shall remove the plants within 3 months from the date on which the tender is accepted.
