5. The lessee shall not put raw manure on the surface of the flower beds. Raw manure should always be covered with a layer of earth at least one inch in thickness so as to prevent the breeding of flies.

The purchaser or his workmen shall not cut down any trees or interfero with any existing fence or boundary.

7. No cattle shall be permitted to graze on the land, and any such animals found grazing thereon will be hable to seizure by the lessor or any person duly authorised by him.

8. The purchaser shall be bound to fence the land leased to him,

pay all rates and taxes, and comply with Municipal regulations.
