MUTTON.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, I, Reginald Sydney Vernon Poulter, Controller of Prices, do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date my Order on Beef and Mutton dated December 6, 1942, and published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,046 of December 6, 1942, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed in respect of mutton for all areas in the Northern Province;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum price per pound above which mutton of the description and grade specified at the heads of those columns shall not be sold in the areas specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of that Schedule;
- (iii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) "Mutton" shall mean the flesh of a sheep or goat and shall exclude all forms of offal and imported meat;
 - (b) "Dead Weight" shall mean the weight of the carcass of any animal as prepared for sale at the slaughter house, *v.e.*, excluding head, hide, entrails, offal, hooves and such parts as are customarily excluded.
- (iv.) direct that every trader who at any premises within the areas specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto sells mutton of the description and grade specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises, a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of mutton of that description and grade;
- (v.) direct that every trader who sells mutton of the description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of that mutton, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the quantity of mutton sold (by weight);
 - (c) the description of mutton sold, and
 - (d) the price paid for the quantity of mutton sold.

VEGEMITE.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, I, Reginald Sydney Vernon Poulter, Controller of Prices, do, by this Order—

- (i.) revoke with effect from this date my Order dated November 19, 1942, and published in *Gazette* No. 9,037 of November 20, 1942, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed in respect of vegemite of the description named and specified in column 1 of the Schedule thereto;
- (ii.) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be the importer's maximum price, the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which vegemite of the description and grade named and specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold by wholesale or by retail, as the case may be, in any part of Ceylon;
- (iii.) direct that paragraphs (ii.), (iii.), (iv.) and (v.) of my Order on Oxo, Bovril, Virol, Vegemite and Marmite dated November 19, 1942, and published in *Gazette* No. 9,037 of November 20, 1942, shall apply in the case of vegemite of the description named and specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto as though those paragraphs were incorporated in this Order;
- (iv.) direct that every importer of, or wholesale trader in, any of the articles specified in the Schedule hereto shall furnish to me at 111, Dam street, Pettah, on or before January 8, 1943, a return stating—
 - (a) the address of every premises in which are contained stocks of any of these articles in his possession or under his control;
 - (b) the quantity and description of the article in each store.

RICE IN 80 MEASURE BAGS (WHOLESALE AND RETAIL).

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, NO. 39 OF 1939.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, I, Dharmapala Wanasundara, Assistant Controller of Prices, Ratnapura District, do, by this Order—

- (1) revoke the Order dated July 6, 1942, of the Deputy Controller of Prices, Ratnapura District, published in *Government Gazette* No. 8,968 of July 17, 1942, in so far as it relates to rice in 80 measure bags;
- (2) fix the prices specified in column 2 as the wholesale dealers' maximum prices per bag of 80 measures, in column 4 as the authorised distributors' maximum retail prices per measure above which rice shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in columns 1 and 3 of the Schedule hereto;
- (3) direct that wholesale dealers and authorised distributors in the areas mentioned in columns 1 and 3 of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at their premises (store or boutique) a notice in which shall be set out the maximum prices for rice fixed by this Order;
- (4) direct that no wholesale dealer or authorised distributor shall sell rice which is adulterated with any other article;
- (5) direct that every person who sells rice by wholesale shall and every person who sells rice by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser of such rice a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the quantity of rice sold;
 - (b) the price paid for the quantity of rice sold;
 - (c) the date of the sale; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or retail;
- (6) direct that for the purposes of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
 - (b) "authorised distributor" means a merchant or other fit and proper person authorised by the Deputy Food Controller under Regulation 5 of Part III., under Head E of the Food Control Regulations, to be distributor of supplies of any controlled commodity for specified areas, institutions or groups of people;
 - (c) "wholesale dealer" means a merchant or other fit and proper person authorised by the Deputy Food Controller under Regulation 5 of Part III., under Head E of the Food Control Regulations, to be a distributor of supplies of any controlled commodity to authorised distributors, depôts or estates;
 - (d) the "wholesale dealers' maximum prices" shall apply only to sales by a wholesale dealer to an authorised distributor or to an estate;
 - (e) the maximum price which may be demanded by a wholesale dealer from an authorised distributor or an estate for any quantity of rice which is less than one bag shall be determined by reference to the maximum price per bag fixed by this Order;
 - (f) the maximum prices fixed by this Order for rice sold by a wholesale dealer are already subject to the reduction allowed to the retailer for the container in which such rice is sold;
 - (g) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart, dry measure, equivalent to one-thirty-second part of a bushel.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, I, Richard Morgan Davies, Deputy Controller of Prices, Ratnapura District, do by this Order—

- (1) revoke my Order dated July 6, 1942, published in *Government Gazette* No. 8,968 of July 17, 1942, in so far as it relates to paddy in 80 measure bags;
- (2) fix the prices specified in column 2 as the wholesale dealers' maximum prices per bag of 80 measures in column 4 as the authorised distributors' maximum retail price per measure above which paddy shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in columns 1 and 3 of the Schedule hereto;
- (3) direct that wholesale dealers and authorised distributors in the areas mentioned in columns 1 and 3 of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at their premises (store or boutique) a notice in which shall be set out the maximum prices for paddy fixed by this Order;
- (4) direct that no wholesale dealer or authorised distributor shall sell paddy which is adulterated with any other article;
- (5) direct that every person who sells paddy by wholesale shall and every person who sells paddy by retail shall on demand, give the purchaser of such paddy a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the quantity of paddy sold;
 - (b) the price paid for the quantity of paddy sold;
 - (c) the date of the sale; and
 - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or retail;
- (6) direct that for the purposes of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of paddy for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
 - (b) "authorised distributor" means a merchant or other fit and proper person authorised by the Deputy Food Controller under Regulation 5 of Part III., under Head E of the Food Control Regulations, to be a distributor of supplies of any controlled commodity for specified areas, institutions, or groups of people;
 - (c) "wholesale dealer" means a merchant or other fit and proper person authorised by the Deputy Food Controller under Regulation 5 of Part III., under Head E of the Food Control Regulations, to be a distributor of supplies of any controlled commodity to authorised distributors, depots or estates;
 - (d) the "wholesale dealers' maximum prices" shall apply only to sales by a wholesale dealer to an authorised distributor or to an estate;

 - (g) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart, dry measure, equivalent to one-thirty-second part of a bushel.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, I, William Holmes, Deputy Controller of Prices, Hambantota District, do by this Order—

- (i.) fix the price, which is for the time being fixed by Order of the Controller of Prices as the maximum retail price per pound above which any article of the description and grade mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo, increased by the amount specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of the Schedule hereto, to be the maximum retail price per pound above which any article of that description and grade shall not be sold within the limits of the Revenue District of Hambantota;
- (ii.) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of any article for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale,
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of any article for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (iii.) direct that no trader shall sell any article of any description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto which is adulterated with a similar article of an inferior description or grade or with any other article;
- (iv.) direct that every trader who, at any premises within the limits of the Revenue District of Hambantota, sells any article of any description or grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of that article;
- (v.) direct that every person who sells by wholesale any article of any description or grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall, and every person who sells by retail any article of any description or grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale;
 - (b) the quantity sold (by weight);
 - (c) the description and grade of the article sold;
 - (d) the price paid; and
 - (e) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.
