THE OMNIBUS SERVICE LICENSING ORDINANCE, No. 47 OF 1942.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred on me by the Order made under section 18 of the Omnibus Service Licensing Ordinance, No. 47 of 1942, and published in *Gazette* No. 9,045 of December 4, 1942, (as amended by any subsequent Order), I, Herman Eric Peries, Acting Commissioner of Motor Transport, do hereby amend the Notification dated December 14, 1942, and published in *Gazette* No. 9,053 of December 18, 1942, by the substitution, in paragraph (b) of that Notification, for all the words from "and that application" to the end of the paragraph, of the following:—

"and—

- (i) that application has not been determined by the Commissioner whether by the grant of the road service licence to the applicant or by the service on him of notice of the refusal of the application; or
- (ii) any appeal preferred against the refusal of the application has not been disposed of whether by a Tribunal of Appeal or by the Supreme Court upon a case stated."

RICE (RETAIL).

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices by section 3, read with section 2 (3), of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, I, Samson Felix Amerasinghe, Deputy Controller of Prices, Kegalla District, do, by this Order:—

- (1) revoke my Order fixing the maximum retail price per measure of rice within the Revenue District of Kegalla, dated October 19, 1942, and published in the *Government Gazette* No. 9,025 of October 28, 1942,
- (2) fix the maximum retail price per measure of rice as follows:—

The authorised distributors in or nearest to the village or bazaar area mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not sell rice of the description and grade specified in column 2 above the maximum retail price per measure specified in column 2 of the said Schedule against the area in which or nearest to which their boutiques or stores are situated;

- (3) direct that the authorised distributors shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at their premises (store or boutique) a notice on which there shall be set out the description and grade of rice for sale and the maximum price of each of them as specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto;
- (4) direct that no authorised distributor shall sell rice of any description and grade specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any article, and that no authorised distributor shall sell rice of any description and grade mixed with rice of another description and grade;
- (5) prescribe that the authorised distributor who sells rice of any description and grade specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto, shall give to the purchaser of that rice, on demand, a receipt on which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the description and grade of rice sold;
  - (b) the quantity of rice sold;
  - (c) the price paid for the quantity of rice sold; and
  - (d) the date of sale;
- (6) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
  - (b) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart, dry measure, equivalent to one-thirty-second part of a bushel;
  - (c) "authorised distributor" means a merchant or other fit and proper person authorised by the Deputy Food Controller, under Regulation 5 of Part III., under Head E of the Food Control Regulations, 1939, to be a distributor of supplies of any controlled commodity for specified areas, institutions or groups of people.

## RICE (WHOLESALE).

## THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

## Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices by section 3, read with section 2 (3), of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939; I, Samson Felix Amerasinghe, Deputy Controller of Prices, Kegalla District, do, by this Order:—

- (1) revoke my Order fixing the maximum wholesale price of rice within the Revenue District of Kegalla, dated October 19, 1942, and published in the *Government Gazette* No. 9,025 of October 28, 1942;
- (2) fix the maximum wholesale price of rice as follows:—  
The wholesale dealers in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not sell rice of the description and grade specified in columns 2 to 3 above the maximum wholesale price per bag specified against their areas in the respective columns of the said Schedule;
- (3) direct that the wholesale dealers in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at their premises (store or boutique) a notice on which there shall be set out the description and grade of rice for sale and the maximum price of each of them as specified in columns 2 to 3 of the Schedule hereto;
- (4) direct that no wholesale dealer shall sell rice of any description and grade mentioned in columns 2 to 3 of the Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any article and that no wholesale dealer shall sell rice of any description and grade mixed with rice of another description and grade;
- (5) prescribe that every wholesale dealer who sells rice of any description and grade mentioned in columns 2 to 3 of the Schedule hereto, shall give to the purchaser of that rice, on demand, a receipt on which there shall be set out—  
(a) the description and grade of rice sold;  
(b) the quantity of rice sold;  
(c) the price paid for the quantity of rice sold; and  
(d) the date of sale;
- (6) direct that for the purpose of this Order—  
(a) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;  
(b) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart, dry measure, equivalent to one-thirty-second part of a bushel;  
(c) "authorised distributor" means a merchant or other fit and proper person authorised by the Deputy Food Controller under Regulation 5 of Part III., under Head E of the Food Control Regulations, 1938, to be a distributor of supplies of any controlled commodity for specified areas, institutions or groups of people;  
(d) "wholesale dealer" means a merchant or any other fit and proper person authorised by the Deputy Food Controller under Regulation 5 of Part III., under Head E of the Food Control Regulations, 1938, to be a distributor of supplies of any controlled commodity to authorised distributors or depots;  
(e) the maximum price which may be demanded by a wholesale dealer from an authorised distributor for any quantity of rice which is less than one bag shall be determined by reference to the maximum price per bag fixed by this Order.

## THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

## Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices, by section 3, read with section 2 (3), of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, I, Samson Felix Amerasinghe, Deputy Controller of Prices, Kegalla District, do, by this Order:—

- (1) revoke my Order fixing the maximum wholesale price of paddy within the Revenue District of Kegalla, dated October 19, 1942, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,025 of October 28, 1942 ;
- (2) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the wholesale dealer's maximum price per bag, above which paddy shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto ;
- (3) direct that wholesale dealers in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at their premises (store or boutique) a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices for paddy fixed by this Order ;
- (4) direct that no wholesale dealer shall sell paddy which is adulterated with any other article ;
- (5) direct that every wholesale dealer who sells paddy shall give to the purchaser, on demand, a receipt on which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the quantity of paddy sold ;
  - (b) the price paid for the quantity of paddy sold ; and
  - (c) the date of sale ;
- (6) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of paddy for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale
  - (b) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart, dry measure, equivalent to one-thirty-second part of a bushel ;
  - (c) "authorised distributor" means a merchant or other fit and proper person authorised by the Deputy Food Controller under Regulation 5 of Part III., under Head E of the Food Control Regulations, 1938, to be a distributor of supplies of any controlled commodity for specified areas, institutions or groups of people ;
  - (d) "wholesale dealer" means a merchant or other fit and proper person authorised by the Deputy Food Controller under Regulation 5 of Part III., under Head E of the Food Control Regulations, 1938, to be a distributor of supplies of any controlled commodity to authorised distributors or depots ;
  - (e) the "wholesale dealer's" maximum price shall apply only to sales by a wholesale dealer to an authorised distributor ;
  - (f) the maximum price which may be demanded by a wholesale dealer from an authorised distributor for any quantity of paddy which is less than one bag shall be determined by reference to the maximum price per bag fixed by this Order.

  - (a) the quantity of paddy sold;
  - (b) the price paid for the quantity of paddy sold; and
  - (c) the date of sale;
