THE DEFENCE (MISCELLANEOUS) REGULATIONS.

Appointment of Competent Authority.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulation 3 of the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do hereby appoint the Controller of Paper to be a competent authority for the whole Island for the purpose of requisitioning paper (including newsprint) under regulation 37 of those Regulations; and accordingly the Notification under the said regulation 3 published in *Gazette* No. 9,066 of January 15, 1943, shall be amended in Part I. of the Schedule thereto by the insertion, in the respective columns immediately after item 1 set out therein, of the following new item:—

THE DEFENCE (MISCELLANEOUS) REGULATIONS.

I, Arthur Courtney Richards, Controller of Paper, being a competent authority duly appointed for the whole Island for the purpose of requisitioning paper under Regulation 37 of the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations, do, by virtue of the powers vested in me by paragraph (4) of that regulation, by this Order—

- (a) direct that no wholesale dealer or retail dealer in paper or printer who, on the date on which this Order is published in the *Gazette*, has in his possession or under his control any stock of paper at any premises in Ceylon, shall remove such paper or cause or permit such paper to be removed from such premises until written permission for the removal of such paper is granted by me; and
- (b) require every person, who is the owner or occupier of any premises in Ceylon on which any paper intended for sale is kept or stored at the date on which this Order is published in the *Gazette*, to send to me within seven days of that date, a declaration setting out the quantity and description of the paper so kept or stored on such premises.
