GREETING :—

WHEREAS I am about to proceed to the North-Central and Central Provinces on the evening of the 4th February, 1943 :

And whereas I am desirous that public business shall be delayed as little as possible by my distance from the seat of Government :

Now know you that I do by these presents, and by virtue of the powers and authorities in that behalf conferred on me by Article XI of the Royal Letters Patent dated the 22nd April, 1931, constitute and appoint you to be my Deputy until my return from the Provinces aforesaid and in that capacity to perform and execute for me and on my behalf any act performable in exercise of the powers and authorities

vested in me by the said Royal Letters Patent or by any Ordinance of this Island which may be recommended by an Officer of State or by a Minister with the approval of his Executive Committee and which shall not in your discretionary judgment require reference to me.

Given at Colombo, this Fourth day of February, 1943, under the hand of the Governor and the Public Seal of the Island.

THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF IMPORTS) REGULATIONS.

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulation 3 of the Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Order amend the Order under that regulation published at page 3 of the *Supplement to Gazette* No. 8,776 of August 1, 1941, (as amended by any subsequent Order), by the addition immediately after sub-paragraph (j) of paragraph (3), of the following new sub-paragraph :—

“(k). Such of the goods specified in items 22 and 43 in the Schedule hereto as may be imported solely for the purpose of re-exportation and may remain under Customs bond until re-exported.”

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulations 3 and 4 of the Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Order amend the First Schedule to the Order under these regulations published at page 5 of the *Supplement to Gazette* No. 8,776 of August 1, 1941, (as amended by any subsequent Order), as follows:—

- (1) by the substitution for item 66 of the following new item:—
“66. Bovril, Virol and Oxo”;
- (2) by the insertion of the following new items after item 66:—
“66A. Marmite . . . I . . . E
66B. Meat extracts other than Bovril, Virol and Oxo . . . I . . . E”; and
- (3) by the omission of items 23, 37, 39, 74 and 75.

THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF IMPORTS) REGULATIONS.
Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulation 4 of the Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Order amend the Schedule to the Order under that regulation published at page 2 of the *Supplement to Gazette* No. 8,855 of January 30, 1942, (as amended by any subsequent Order), as follows:—

- (1) by the insertion, immediately after item 3, of the following new item:—
“3A. Cereal foods (prepared) falling under the heading “Cereal foods (prepared) not elsewhere specified” in Class I Group E of the classification in the Ceylon Customs Tariff . . . I . . . E”;
- (2) by the insertion, immediately after item 8A, of the following new items:—
“8B. Fruits, dried or otherwise preserved (except in sugar) with the exception of currents, dates, raisins and prunes . . . I . . . E

8C. Fruits, preserved in sugar, syrup or spirits, other than jams, jellies or marmalades . . . I . . . E; and

(3) by the insertion, immediately after item 21A, of the following new items:—

“21B. Ovaltine . . . I . . . E
21C. Bournvita and Mellin's Foods. I . . . E”.

The War Risks (Goods) Insurance Regulations, 1942, published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 8,870 of February 23, 1942, are hereby amended in regulation 5 (1) by the substitution for the words “at the rate of three-eighths per cent. per month or part of a month”, of the words “at the rate of three-sixteenths per cent. per month or part of a month”.
