THE URBAN COUNCILS ORDINANCE.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 251A of the Urban Councils Ordmance, No. 61 of 1939, I, Andrew Caldecott. Governor of Ceylon, do by this Order authorize the Matara Urban Council to declare by resolution—

- (1) that any by-law made by that Council for the provision of pensions or gratuities to the widows, children, next of kin, or dependants of deceased officers or servants shall be applicable retrospectively to the case of any deceased officer or servant, where that Council is satisfied that such officer or servant died while in the service of that Council and on a date not earlier than the first day of January, 1933;
- (2) that any pension granted in pursuance of such resolution to the widow or children of any deceased officer or servant shall be payable with effect from the date of the death of such officer or servant.

Schedule.

The area bounded as follows:--

East: From the 12th mile on the Mannar Madawachchia Road up to Rattaikulam including the Animal Breeding Centre.

North: From the 12th mile channel near the 12th mile on up to Nanaddan Mannar Madawachchia road Junction.

West: The road from Nanaddan to Periyapullichchipotkeni

West: The road from Nanaddan to Periyapuntenenipotkeni up to the Aruvi Aru.

South: From Rattaikulam by a direct line to Murunkan-Silavatturai Road and then along that road up to the Aruvi Aru and including the following villages, Murunkan, Koraimoddai, Kannaddi, Sirukandal, Parikarikandal, Rattakulam, Kollar-Sirukkulam, Semmauthivu, Kankanitivu, Vanchiankulam, Pichchaikulam, Pallankoddai, Moddaikadai, Nochchikulam, Athikuli, Kusavankuli, Malaiyiddan, Alavakkai Pothurakandan, Puyarasankulam, Pidarikulam, kai, Puthırakandan, Puvarasankulám, Pıdarıkulam, Mavilankeni, Pericharkaddu, Puthuvelı and Chudikullı.

# CANE JAGGERY (SAKKARAI).

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939. Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, I, Wilfrid Ernest Hobday, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Colombo District, do, by this Order-

(1) fix the price, which is for the time being fixed by the order of the Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), as the maximum retail price per pound above which cane jaggery (Sakkarai) of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of Colombo, mercased by the amounts specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule heroto as the maximum retail price per pound above which cane jaggory (Sakkarai) of that description and grade shall not be sold within the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Second Schedule;

(2) direct that no trader shall sell any article of any description or grade mentioned in the First Schedule which is adulterated with any other article of an inferior description and grade or quality;

(3) direct that any trader who, at any promises within the Colombo District (excluding the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo), sells any article of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises, a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect

out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of that article of that description and grade;

(4) direct that every person who sells by retail any article of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule bootst abell. Schedule hereto, shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that article a receipt on which there shall be set

(a) the date of the sale;

(b) the description and grade of the article sold;

(c) the weight of the quantity sold; and (d) the price paid for the quantity sold;

(5) direct that for the purpose of this Order any sale of any quantity of cane jaggery (Sakkarai) for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;

(6) direct that every trador who has no stocks of cane jaggery (Sakkarai) of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto available for sale shall exhibit at his premises a notice to the effect that stocks of cane jaggery (Sakkarai) are not available for sale for time being.

BY virtue of powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices by section 3, read with section 2 (3), of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, I, Samson Felix Amerasinghe, Deputy Controller of Prices, Kegalla District, do, by this Order-

(1) fix the price which is for the time being fixed by Order of the Controller of Prices as the maximum wholesale price per bag above which sugar of the description and grade specified in columns 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the Muncipal limits of Colombo, increased by the amounts specified in columns 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule hereto, as the maximum wholesale price per bag above which sugar of the description and grade mentioned in the respective columns shall not be sold in the areas respective columns shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the said Schedule;

(2) direct that paragraphs 2 and 3 of my Order in respect of wholesale price of sugar dated September 24, 1942, and published in Government Gazette No. 9,017 of October 2, 1942, shall apply in the case of sugar of the description and grade specified in columns 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule heroto as though those paragraphs were incorporated in this Order.
