GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS.

THE FOOD CONTROL ORDINANCE.

Notification.

IT is hereby notified in terms of section 4 (3) of the Food Control Ordinance (Chapter 132) read with the Defence (Food and Price Control) (Transfer of Powers) Regulations, 1942, that the Orders specified in the Schedule hereto made by me under section 4 (1) of the Ordinance, and published in *Gazette* No. 9,112 of April 21, 1943, have been confirmed by the Board of Ministers on April 27, 1943.

Schedule.

1. Order No. 52 under section 4 (1) (a) prohibiting the transport or removal of paddy or other grain or any preparation

made mainly or wholly from such grain from certain areas except under permit.

2. Order No. 53 under section 4 (1) (d) prohibiting the removal from the Customs premises of any rice, paddy, wheat, wheat flour or kurakkan which is imported into Ceylon, except under permit.

3. Order No. 54 under section 4 (1) (e) assuming control of every granary, warehouse or store in the Chalmers Granaries and the Manning Market in which rice is stored for the purpose of trade.

4. Order No. 55 under section 4 (1) (g) directing the Food Controller to take steps for the allocation of supplies of paddy or other grain or any preparation made mainly or wholly from such grain to merchants and distributors in certain parts of Ceylon, and to organise and administer a system of rationing such supplies.
