REGULATION 43D.

ORDER made by the Governor under Regulation 43D of the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations.

Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Controlled Articles (Chillie Powder) Order, 1943.

2. In this Order—

“chillie powder” means the powder made or prepared out of dried chillies, whether or not such chillies have been imported or grown in the Peninsula, and includes any powder constituted by the mixture of chillie powder with any other substance;

“Peninsula” means the Jaffna Peninsula.

3. Chillie powder is hereby declared to be a controlled article within the meaning of Regulation 43D of the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations for the purposes of the application of the provisions of that Regulation to chillie powder.

4. The provisions of paragraph 2 and of paragraphs 4 to 9 (inclusive) of the Controlled Articles (Chillies and Onions) Order, 1943, shall apply to chillie powder in like manner as they apply to chillies grown in the Peninsula.
