THE DEFENCE (TRADING WITH THE ENEMY) REGULATIONS, 1939

THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY (CUSTODIAN) **ORDER**, 1940

WHEREAS the immovable property more fully described

in the Schedule hereto belongs to Aiumugam Vythilingham And whereas the said Arumugam Vythilingham is now believed to be residing in Kota Bharu in the Federated Malay States, and is an enemy within the meaning of the Defence

States, and is an enemy within the meaning of the Detence (Trading with the Enemy) Regulations, 1939, read with the Defence (Trading with the Enemy) (Amendment) Regulations And whereas it is expedient that a Vesting Order should be made in respect of the said immovable property and such powers in regard thereto as are hereinafter contained should be conferred upon the Custodian of Enemy Property

Now therefore, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon; by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Defence (Trading with the Enemy) Regulations, 1939, the Defence (Trading with the Enemy) Amendment Regulations and the Trading with the Enemy (Custodian) Order, 1940, and all other powers enabling me in that behalf do hereby order enabling me in that behalf, do hereby order-

(1) that all the right, title and interest of the said Arumugam Vythilingham to and in the said immovable property do vest in the Custodian of Enemy Property,

(2) that the said Custodian is to be at liberty to transfer,

sell or realise the said immovable property, and

(3) that the said Custodian do have all such powers as may be necessary for the purposes of the transfer, sale and realisation of the said immovable property, including the power to employ such agents as he may consider necessary for such purposes

Regulation

The Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations published in the Supplement to Gazette No 8,533 of October 20, 1939, as amended by any subsequent defence regulation are hereby further amended, by the addition, immediately after Regulation 14A thereof, of the following new regulation

safeguards for certain areas

(1) If the Governor is satisfied with respect to any area that it is necessary or expedient, in the interests of the defence of the Island or the efficient prosecution of the war, to take special precautions for safeguarding information with respect to that area which would or might be useful to the enemy, he may by Order apply this regulation to that area
(2) While this regulation applies to any

area, any authorised officer may

- (a) detain and search any person who appears to such officer to be about to leave or to have recently left that area, and any article which that person has with him, for the purpose of ascertaining whether that person has in his possession any such document or record as is referred to in regulation 14 of these regulations, and
- (b) detain and search any goods consigned from that area to a destination outside that area for the purpose of ascertam ing whether they contain any such document or record,

and may seize any article found upon such search which appears to such officer to be, or to be capable of being, such a document or record

(3) Where any person-

- (a) is about to leave an area to which this regulation applies on or in any vehicle,
- vessel or aircraft, or
 (b) arrives on or in any vehicle, vessel or aircraft from such an area at a place in Ceylon outside that area,

any authorised officer may enter or go on board the vehicle, vessel or aircraft for the purpose of o (D S 283) exercising the powers conferred on him by the last preceding paragraph, and may also-

- (1) examine or search the vehicle, vessel or aircraft for the purpose of ascertaining whether there is on or in the vehicle, vessel or airciaft any such document or record as is referred to in regulation 14 of these regulations, and
- (11) seize any article found upon such exami nation or search which appears to such officer to be, or to be capable of being, such a document or record
- (4) No female shall be searched under this regulation except by a female, and any female whom it is proposed to search under this regulation may be taken to such place as may be necessary in order to secure compliance with this paragraph

, (5) Any article seized under this regulation may be retained for such period and dealt with in such manner as may be directed by or on behalf of the Governor, and in particular, but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing words, may be subjected to any process and may be wholly or partly destroyed or obliterated

(6) The competent authority of any area to which this regulation is applied by an Order under paragraph (1) shall cause notice of the effect of such Order to be given as soon as may be in such manner as he thinks necessary for bringing it to the notice of persons in, or in the vicinity of, that area, and to the notice of any other persons who in the opinion of the com petent authority ought to have notice thereof
(7) "Authorised officer" for the purposes of

this regulation means any police officer not below the rank of Sergeant, or a member of His Majesty's forces acting in the course of his duty as such, or any person authorised in that behalf by the Governor '

the Gazette, the Scheme prepared under that section of the Ordinance and published in Gazette No 9,017 of October 2, 1942, shall be amended as follows

- (1) in paragraph 1, by the addition, immediately after the definition of "Superfluous teacher", of the follow
 - "special post" has the same meaning as in the Code of Regulations for Assisted English Schools",
- (2) in paragraph 4, by the substitution, for the words "The number of teachers", of the following
 - "Subject to the provisions of paragraph 4A, the number of teachers",
- (3) by the addition, immediately after paragraph 4, of the following new paragraph
