**An Ordinance to amend the Estate Labour (Indian)  
Ordinance**

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice  
and consent of the State Council thereof, as follows —

Short title

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Estate Labour  
(Indian) Amendment Ordinance, No of 1943

2 Section 5 of the Estate Labour (Indian) Ordinance,  
(hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"), is  
hereby amended, by the substitution, for the words "an  
advance of money from the employer," of the words "from  
the employer any advance of wages in respect of which the  
employer is authorised, by or under the provisions of any  
other written law, to make a deduction from the wages of the  
labourer,"

in sub-section (4) thereof, by the substitution, for all the

5 Schedule A to the principal Ordinance is hereby

by or under the provisions of any other written law from  
the wages of the plaintiff or each of the plaintiffs and shall  
apply the amount of such deductions"

## Objects and Reasons

In the Bill to amend the Wages Boards Ordinance, No 27 of  
1941, which will be introduced in the State Council at the same  
time as this Bill, it is proposed to restrict the matters in  
respect of which deductions can be made from wages paid to  
workers and to prescribe the manner in which such deductions  
are to be made. The object of this Bill is to effect in the  
Estate Labour (Indian) Ordinance (Chapter 112) certain  
consequential amendments which will be necessary if the  
proposals made in Clause 2 of the Wages Boards (Amendment)  
Bill are accepted by the Council
