NOTICE is hereby given that the Govennment Agent, Western Province, will receive sealed tenders for mining plumbago for a period of one year subject to the following conditions in the Crown lands called Digalakanda described in the Schedule hereto.

Tenders which must be enclosed in sealed envelopes superscribed "Tenders for Mining Plumbago" will be received at the Colombo Kachcheri until 10-30 Am on October 29, 1943, when they will be opened.
