THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF IMPORTS) REGULATIONS.

43/2/34 (FSO)

*Order.*

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulation 3 of the Defence (Control of Imports) Regulations, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Order—

(1) prohibit the importation into Ceylon—

- (a) of any currency note issued by the Government of Hong Kong; and
- (b) of any bank note issued by any bank in Hong Kong;

(2) exempt from the prohibition imposed by paragraph (1) any such note which is brought into Ceylon by any person who proves to the satisfaction of the Controller that he departed from a port or place in Hong Kong or China before the thirty-first day of December, 1941.
