THE DEFENCE (MISCELLANEOUS) REGULATIONS.

Order under Regulation 43.

ORDER made by the Governor by virtue of the powers vested in him by Regulation 43 of the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations.

Order.

The Lighting Restriction (Motor Cars) Order, 1942, published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 8,877 of March 9, 1942, is hereby amended as follows:—

(1) in paragraph 2 of that Order, by the substitution, for all the words from "shall either—" to the end of that paragraph, of the following:—

"shall each be fitted with a mask in accordance with the specification set out in Schedule B to this Order, so, however, that no light from such headlight shall, when such headlight is fitted with such mask, reach the ground at any point further than twenty-five yards from the headlight when the motor car is standing on a level surface.

The outer surface of each such mask and of the semi-circular cowl attached thereto (including the front surface of the cowl) shall be painted black or dark khaki."

(2) in paragraph 3 of that Order—

(a) in sub-paragraph (1), by the substitution, for all the words from “ in Schedule B to this Order ” to the end of that sub-paragraph, of the following :—

“ in Schedule B to this Order—

- (i.) the front surface of the semi-circular cowl attached to each mask shall be painted red ;
- (ii.) the outer surface of each mask and of the semi-circular cowl attached thereto (other than the front surface of such cowl) shall be painted black or dark khaki ; and
- (iii.) the mask fitted to the headlight on the near side of such fire engine, ambulance or motor car shall be fitted with a special distinctive recognition device of a type specially or generally approved by the Minister for the purpose.” ;

(b) in sub-paragraph (2), by the substitution, for all the words from “ with a mask ” to the end of that sub-paragraph, of the following :—

“ with a mask, semi-circular cowl or distinctive recognition device of the description set out in that sub-paragraph ”.

(3) in paragraph 9 (1) of that Order—

(a) by the omission of the words “ at all times between the hours of sunset and sunrise,” ; and

(b) by the substitution, for the words “ in any part,” of the words “ in any park,” ; and

(4) by the omission of Schedule A to that Order.
