THE FOOD CONTROL ORDINANCE.

Order No. 17.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 (1) (a) of the Food Control Ordinance (Chapter 132), I, George Claude Stanley Corea, Minister for Labour, Industry and Commerce, do by this Order prohibit the transport or removal of paddy or other grain from the areas specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto, except under the authority of a permit issued by the person mentioned in the corresponding entry in the second column of that Schedule.

THE FOOD CONTROL ORDINANCE.

Order No. 18.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 (1) (g) of the Food Control Ordinance (Chapter 132), I, George Claude Stanley Corea, Minister for Labour, Industry and Commerce, do by this Order direct the Food Controller to take steps for the allocation of supplies of rice and paddy to merchants and distributors in all parts of Ceylon other than the areas mentioned in the Schedule hereto, and to organize and administer a system of rationing such supplies on and after the date hereof.

THE FOOD CONTROL ORDINANCE.

Order No. 19.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 (1) (d) of the Food Control Ordinance (Chapter 132), I, George Claude Stanley Corea, Minister for Labour, Industry and Commerce, do by this Order prohibit the removal from the Customs premises at any port or place mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto, of any rice or paddy which is imported into Ceylon, except under a permit issued by the person mentioned in the corresponding entry in the second column of that Schedule, and except in accordance with such directions as he may issue in regard to the time at which, the manner in which, and the place to which such rice or paddy may be so removed.
