BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), by section 3 (read with section 2(3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No 2) Regulations, I, Chinnappah Coomaraswamy, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Badulla District, do, by this Order-

- (1) revoke with effect from this date my Orders— (a) dated June 27, 1943, published in Government Gazette No 9,142 of July 2, 1943,
 - (b) dated June 8, 1943, published in Government Gazette No 9,134 of June 11, 1913
 - (c) dated July 3, 1943, published in Government Gazette No 9,145 of July 9, 1943,
- (2) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the First Schedule hereto, to be respectively, the maximum wholesale prices per bag of 80 measures of all varieties of rice and the maximum wholesale price per bag of 112 measures of all varieties of nice, above which rice of all varieties shall not be sold in the aleas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column I of the First Schedule hereto,
- (3) fix the prices specified in column 4 of the First Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per bag of 80 measures of whole wheat, above which whole wheat shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto,

(4) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices per measure of rice of all varieties, above which rice of all varieties shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto,

(5) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices per measure of bajrı (cambu), above which bajrı (cambu) shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the

Second Schedule hereto, (6) fix the prices specified in column 3 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price per measure of whole wheat, above which whole wheat shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding

entry in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto,
(7) direct that every trader who sells any articles of the
description and grade mentioned in the First and
Second Schedules hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his piemises (store or boutique) a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices of that article fixed by this Order,

(8) direct that no person shall sell any article of the description and grade mentioned in the First and Second Schedules hereto which is adulterated with

any other article,

- (9) direct that every person who sells any articles of the description and grade specified in the First Schedule hereto by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any articles of the description and grade specified in the Second Schedule hereto by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale.

(b) the quantity of the article sold,

- (c) the price paid for the quantity of the article sold, (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail,
- (10) direct that for the purposes of this Order-
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of any article mentioned in the First Schedule hereto for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by whole-
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of any article mentioned in the First and Second Schedules for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
 - (c) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart, dry measure, and
 (d) the maximum wholesale price which may be
 - demanded for any quantity of rice of all varieties or whole wheat, which is less than a bag shall be determined by reference to the wholesale price per bag of all varieties of lice or whole wheat fixed by this Order
