 - (a) the quantity, description and sizes of the Spearfast Tubular Frame Saws and spare blades sold,
 - (b) the price paid, and
 - (c) the date of the sale

WHEAT FLOUR.

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No 39 OF 1939

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No 2) Regulations, I, Reginald Sydney Vernon Poulter, Controller of Prices (Food), do, by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date my Order dated August 31, 1943, published in Ceylon Government Gazette No 9,166 of September 3, 1943, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed in respect of flour of the description and grade specified in the First Schedule hereto,
- (ii) fix the price specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price per lb above which wheat flour shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo,
- (iii) direct that no person shall sell any wheat flour which is adulterated with any other article,
- (iv) direct that every trader who at any premises within the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo sells any wheat flour shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order in respect of wheat flour, and
- (v) direct that every person who sells any wheat flour within the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo shall give the purchaser of that wheat flour, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale,
 - (b) the weight of wheat flour sold,
 - (c) the price paid for the quantity of wheat flour sold

RICE, WHOLE WHEAT, BAJRI (CAMBU)

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No 39 of 1939

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food) by section 3, read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No 2) Regulations, I, Chinnappa Coomaraswamy, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Badulla District do, by this Order—

- (1) revoke with effect from this date my Order dated October 25, 1943, published in *Government Gazette* No 9,187 of October 29, 1943, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices of rice, wheat, and bajri (cambu) fixed within the Badulla District,
- (2) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the First Schedule hereto to be respectively, the maximum wholesale prices per bag of 80 measures and per bag of 112 measures of all varieties of rice, above which rice of all varieties shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of that Schedule,
- (3) fix the prices specified in column 4 of the First Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per bag of 80 measures of whole wheat, above which whole wheat shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto,
- (4) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices per measure of rice of all varieties above which rice of all varieties shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto,
- (5) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices per measure of bajri (cambu), above which a bajri (cambu) shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto,
- (6) fix the prices specified in column 3 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price per measure of whole wheat, above which whole wheat shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto,
- (7) direct that the provisions of sections (7), (8), (9), and (10) of my Order dated July 27, 1943, and published in *Government Gazette* No 9,152 of July 30, 1943, shall apply to this Order as if those sections were herein incorporated

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No 39 OF 1939

Order

BY virtue of powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), by section 3, read with section 2 (3) of the Control Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, I, Mylvaganam Selvadurai, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Vavuniya District, do, by this Order—

- (1) fix the prices which for the time being fixed by Order of the Controller of Prices under section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as the maximum retail price above which Bombay Onions mentioned in the First Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of Colombo increased by the amounts specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto as the maximum retail price above which Bombay Onions of the description shall not be sold in the area mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Second Schedule,
- (ii) direct for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of Bombay Onions for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
 - (b) "Maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail,
- (iii) direct that where Bombay Onions mentioned in the First Schedule hereto sold by retail, the sale shall be made according to the weight or measure specified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of the First Schedule hereto,
- (iv) direct that no trader shall sell Bombay Onions of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any other article or with an article of an inferior description and grade or quality,
- (v) direct that any trader who, at any premises within the limits of any area mentioned in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, sells Bombay Onions of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises, a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order in respect of that Bombay Onions of that description and grade,
- (vi) direct that every person who sells by retail Bombay Onions of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto shall on demand give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of the sale, (b) the description and the grade of the Bombay Onions sold, (c) the weight of the quantity of the Bombay Onions sold, (d) price paid for the Bombay Onions sold and, (e) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by retail
