#### RICE (WHOLESALE AND RETAIL)

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No 39 OF 1939

Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), by section 3, read with section 2 (3), of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as amended by the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions) Regulations, I, Philip James Hudson, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Kalutara District, do, by this Order—

- (1) revoke my Order dated November 1, 1943, and November 13, 1943, published in *Government Gazettes* Nos 9,196 of November 12, 1943, and 9,201 of November 19, 1943, respectively, in so far as they relate to the maximum wholesale and retail prices of rice fixed in respect of the areas specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto,
- (2) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum wholesale prices per bag and the maximum retail prices per measure above which rice shall not be sold in the areas specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto,
- (3) direct that every trader who sells rice in any area specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous place at his premises (store or boutique) a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order for that area,
- (4) direct that no person shall sell rice which is adulterated with any other article,
- (5) direct that every person who sells rice by wholesale or by retail shall on demand give the purchaser of that rice a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of the sale,
  - (b) the quantity of rice sold,
  - (c) the price paid for the quantity of rice sold,
  - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail,
- (6) direct that for the purposes of this Order—
  - (a) a bag of rice including raw rice shall contain 80 measures,
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
  - (c) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
  - (d) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart, dry measure,
  - (e) the maximum price which may be demanded for any quantity of rice which is more or less than one bag or one measure, as the case may be, shall be determined by reference to the maximum price per bag or measure fixed by this Order,
  - (f) the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of the container in which the rice is sold,

  - (b) any sale of any quantity of Wheat Flour for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale,
  - (c) any sale of any quantity of Wheat Flour for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
  - (d) "pound" shall be deemed to be the standard pound, avoirdupois weight, equivalent to one hundred and twelfth part of a hundredweight,
  - (e) the maximum price which may be demanded for any quantity of Wheat Flour which is more or less than one bag or one pound, as the case may be, shall be determined by reference to the maximum price per bag or pound fixed by this Order.

(2) fix the price specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum price above which any bricks of the description specified in column 1 of the same Schedule shall not be sold *ex kiln* at any place within the Kandy District and Uda Hewaheta Division in the Nuwara Eliya District,

(3) direct that every person who sells *ex kiln* within the Kandy District and Uda Hewaheta Division in the Nuwara Eliya District any bricks of any description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at that kiln a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order,

(4) direct that every person who sells *ex kiln* within the Kandy District and Uda Hewaheta Division in the Nuwara Eliya District any bricks of any description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of such bricks a receipt on which there shall be set out—

- (a) the number of bricks sold,
- (b) the price paid for the bricks sold,
- (c) the description of the bricks sold,
- (d) the date of the sale, and
- (e) the kiln from which the bricks were sold
