THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, NO 39 OF 1939

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No 2) Regulations, I, William Holmes, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Hambantota District, do by this Order—

- (1) revoke with effect from this date my order dated April 12, 1943, published in Government Gazette No 9,110 of April 16, 1943, relating to maximum prices of country rice, issued for the Hambantota District,
- (11) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the First Schedule hereto, to be the maximum wholesale price per bag of 80 measures, above which rice shall not be sold within the respective areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto,
- (111) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto, to be the maximum retail price per measure, above which rice shall not be sold within the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto,
- (iv) direct that every trader who sells lice in the areas mentioned m column 1 of the First Schedule and the Second Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises (store or boutique) a notice in which shall be set out the maximum prices for rice fixed by this Order,
- (v) direct that no person shall sell rice which is a dulterated with any other article , $% \left(\frac{1}{2}\right) =\frac{1}{2}\left(\frac{1}{2}\right) =\frac{1}{2$
- (v1) direct that every person who sells rice by wholesale shall, and every person who sells rice by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that rice a receipt in which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of sale,

 - (b) the quantity of rice sold,
 (c) the price paid for the quantity of rice sold, and
 (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say,
 - whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail,
- (vii) direct that for the purpose of this Order-
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by whole
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
 (c) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard

 - (d) the maximum wholesale price which may be demanded for any quantity of rice which is less than one bag shall be determined by refer ence to the maximum wholesale price per bag fixed by this Order

- (1) revoke, with effect from this date, my order dated February 6, 1943, published in Ceylon Government Gazette No 9,084 of February 12, 1943, relating to maximum prices of sugar, issued for the Hambantota District.

- (7) direct that every person who sells any sugar by whole sale shall and every person who sells any sugar by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt on which there shall be set out—
 - (a) the date of sale,
 - (b) the quantity of sugar sold (by weight),
 - (c) the description and grade of sugar sold,

(d) the price paid for the quantity of sugar sold, and(e) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail,

 - (e) "Maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail,
- (4) direct that no person shall sell the articles mentioned in the First Schedule hereto, which is adulterated with any other article of an inferior description or grade or quality,
- (5) direct that every person who at any premises within the areas mentioned in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto sells the articles mentioned in the First Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises, a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of that article of that description and grade,
- (6) direct that every person who sells by wholesale shall, and every person who sells by retail shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out—

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No 39 of 1939

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested m the Deputy Controller of Prices by section 3 read with section 2 (3) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No 2) Regula tions, I, Richard Montagu Gybbon Monypenny, Deputy Controller of Prices, Nuwara Eliya District, do, by this Order—

(1) revoke with effect from this date my Order dated September 29, 1943, published in *Government Gazette* No 9,179 of October 8, 1943,

(2) fix the price specified in any Order for the time being in force made by the Controller of Prices (Food) under section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, as the dealer's maximum price per cwt (naked and for quantities over 14 lb) and dealer's maximum price per pound (naked and for quantities of 14 lb or less) above which coconut poonac shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo, increased by the amounts specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the dealer's maximum price per cwt (naked and for quantitities over 14 lb) and dealer's

maximum price per pound (naked and for do of 14 lb or less) respectively, above which poonac shall not be sold within the respective mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto

(3) direct that for the purpose of this Order—

(a) "Dealer" shall mean any person or Comother than a miller who sells coconut poo

(b) "the Dealer's maximum price per cwt" she apply to any sale of coconut poonac of over 14 lb at a time made by a dealer, and (c) "the dealer's maximum price per lb" shall

c) "the dealer's maximum piece per lb "shal apply to any sale of coconut poonac of 14 lb or less at a time made by a dealer,"

(4) direct that maximum piece fixed by this Order shall not include the price of the container in which the coconut poonac is sold,

(5) direct that no dealer shall sell coconut poonac which is adulterated with any other article,

(6) direct that every dealer who at any premises within the areas specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto sells coconut poonac, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which then shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order,

(7) direct that every person who sells coconut poonac shall, on demand, give the purchaser a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the date of sale,

(b) the quantity sold,

(c) the description of the article sold, and

(d) the price paid for the quantity sold
