#### SOAP (LOCALLY MANUFACTURED).

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No 39 OF 1939

#### Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date my Orders on soaps (locally manufactured)—
  - (a) dated March 24, 1943, published in *Government Gazette* No 9,103 of March 26, 1943, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed in respect of Maya toilet soap,
  - (b) dated August 3, 1943, published in *Government Gazette* No 9,154 of August 6, 1943, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed in respect of Mikado soap,
  - (c) dated November 13, 1943, published in *Government Gazette* No 9,201 of August 6, 1943,
- (ii) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3, and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the manufacturer's maximum price to a wholesale dealer per case, the maximum wholesale price per case and the maximum retail price per tablet or bar, as the case may be, above which soap of the description and grade specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold by wholesale or by retail, as the case may be, in any part of Ceylon,
- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of any article specified in column (1) of the Schedule hereto for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale,
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of any article specified in column (1) of the Schedule hereto for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
  - (c) "manufacturer" shall mean any person or firm or association of persons who manufactures any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto,
  - (d) a "wholesale dealer" shall mean any person who has been in the habit of selling for resale any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto,
  - (e) "manufacturer's maximum price" shall apply to any sale by wholesale by a manufacturer to a wholesale dealer,
  - (f) "maximum wholesale price" shall apply to all sales by wholesale except sales by a manufacturer to a wholesale dealer,
  - (g) "maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail,
- (iv) direct that every trader who at any premises in Ceylon sells soap of any description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of soap of that description and grade,
- (v) direct that every person who sells soap of the description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of that soap a receipt, on demand, in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of the sale,
  - (b) the quantity of soap sold,
  - (c) the description and grade of soap sold,
  - (d) the price paid for the quantity of soap sold, and
  - (e) the nature of transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail,
- (vi) direct that every trader who has at any time during the three months prior to this date sold any article mentioned in the Schedule hereto and has for the time being no stocks of that article available for sale shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises a notice to the effect that stocks of that article are not available for sale for the time being

- (ii) direct that for the purpose of this Order, any sale for the purpose of use, of any tube specified in the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
- (iii) direct that every trader, who at any premises in Ceylon, sells tubes of the description and grades specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises the maximum prices fixed by this Order for tubes of that description and grade,
- (iv) direct that every person, who sells tubes of the description and grade specified in the Schedule hereto, shall give to every purchaser of tubes a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the quantity, description, and grade of the tube sold,
  - (b) the price paid, and
  - (c) the date and place of the sale,

- (i) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which slate pencils of the description specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon,
- (ii) direct that every person, who at any premises in Ceylon sells any slate pencils of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at these premises, a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of slate pencils of that description,
- (iii) direct that any person, who at any premises deals or has at any time during the three months prior to this date dealt in slate pencils of the description mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto and has for the time being no stocks of such slate pencils available for sale, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice to the effect that he has no stocks available for sale for the time being,

- (ii) direct that for the purpose of this Order any sale for the purpose of use of plate glass referred to in the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
- (iii) direct that every dealer, who at any premises in Ceylon, sells any plate glass of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of plate glass,

- (i) revoke with effect from this date my Order dated July 30, 1943, published in *Government Gazette* No 9,154 of August 6, 1943, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed in respect of soap mentioned in the Schedule hereto,
- (ii) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the importer's maximum price to a wholesale dealer, the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which soap of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon,
- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) any sale of the soap specified in the Schedule hereto, for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale,
  - (b) any sale of the soap specified in the Schedule hereto other than a sale by wholesale as defined above shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
  - (c) "importer's maximum price" shall apply to any sale by an importer to a wholesale dealer,
  - (d) "maximum wholesale price" shall apply to all sales by wholesale except sales by an importer to a wholesale dealer,
  - (e) "maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail,
- (iv) direct that every person who sells any soap specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall give to every purchaser of such soap on demand a receipt in which their shall be set out—
  - (a) the quantity and description of the soap sold,
  - (b) the price paid,
  - (c) the date of the sale, and
  - (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the transaction was by wholesale or by retail
- (v) direct that every trader, who, at any premises in Ceylon sells any soap of the description specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of soap of that description

**THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No 39 OF 1939**

*Order*

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Food) by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No 2) Regulations, I, Alfred Silva Kohomban Wickrema, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Matara District, do, by this Order—

- (1) revoke with effect from this date my Order dated March 4, 1943, published in *Government Gazette* No 9,096 dated March 12, 1943, prescribing the maximum prices for pulses within the Revenue District of Matara,
- (2) fix the price which is for the time being fixed by the Order of the Controller of Prices (Food) as the maximum wholesale price per hundredweight above which articles of the description and grade stated in the First Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of Colombo, increased by the amount specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto as the maximum wholesale price per hundredweight above which articles of that description and grade shall not be sold within the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto,
- (3) fix the price which is for the time being fixed by the Order of the Controller of Prices (Food) as the maximum retail price per measure above which articles of the description and grade stated in the First Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of Colombo, increased by the amount specified in column 3 of the Second Schedule hereto as the maximum retail price per measure above which articles of that description and grade shall not be sold within the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto,
- (4) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of any article for the purpose of resale or any sale of any article in a quantity of 200 lb or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale,
  - (b) any sale of any quantity less than 200 lb of any article for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
  - (c) "wholesale dealer" shall mean any person who is in the habit of selling by wholesale any article mentioned in the First Schedule hereto,
  - (d) "maximum wholesale price" shall apply to all sales by wholesale except sales by an importer to a wholesale dealer,
  - (e) "maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail,
- (5) direct that no trader shall sell any article of any description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any other article or with any article of an inferior description and grade or quality,

(6) direct that any trader, who, at any premises within the District of Matara sells any article of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order in respect of that article of that description and grade,

(7) direct that every person who sells by wholesale any article of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto shall, and every person who sells by retail any article of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto shall, on demand give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the date of sale,
- (b) the description and grade of the article sold,
- (c) the weight of the quantity sold if sold by wholesale, and the volume, in measures of the quantity sold if sold by retail,
- (d) the price paid for the quantity sold,
- (e) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Food) by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No 2) Regulations, I, Jonathan Goonewardene, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Matara District, do, by this Order—

- (1) revoke with effect from this date the Order dated July 1, 1943, published in *Government Gazette* No 9,145 of July 9, 1943, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed for chilly powder and curry powder containing chillies,
- (2) fix the price which is for the time being fixed by the Order of the Controller of Prices (Food) as the

maximum price per pound above which articles of the description and grade stated in the First Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of Colombo, increased by the amount specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto as the maximum price per pound above which articles of that description and grade shall not be sold within the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto,

(3) direct that for the purpose of this order "curry powder" shall mean any mixture containing any two or more of the following cury stuffs in powdered form—

Chillies, coriander, pepper, cumin seed, fennel seed, mathe seed turmeric, cinnamon, cloves, cardamom, nutmeg and salt,

(4) direct that no person shall sell any powdered chillies mixed with any article or articles other than one or more of the following —

Coriander, pepper, cumin seed, fennel seed, mathe seed, turmeric, cinnamon, cloves, cardamom, nutmeg and salt,

(5) direct that no person shall sell any powdered chillies mixed with any article or articles, as allowed by clause (4) above, unless the mixture contains not less than 20 per cent of powdered chillies by weight,

(6) direct that no person shall sell any curry powder containing any article or articles other than those specified in clause (3) above,

(7) direct that no person shall sell any curry powder made by the India Condiment Co., for the Government of Ceylon, except in unopened one pound packets bearing the following marks —

Curry powder specially prepared for the Government of Ceylon by India Condiment Co.,  
Madras, 1 lb net

(8) direct that every trader who, at any premises within the District of Matara, sells any article specified in the First Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of those articles,

(9) direct that every person who sells by wholesale any article of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto shall, and every person who sells by retail any article of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the date of the sale,
- (b) the quantity sold (by weight),
- (c) the description of the article sold (specifying whether it contains chilly powder or not),
- (d) the price paid for the quantity sold,
- (e) the nature of the transaction, that is to say whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail,

(10) direct that for the purpose of this Order—

- (a) any sale of any quantity of any article for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale,
- (b) any sale of any quantity of any article for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No 39 OF 1939

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food) by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as amended by the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions) No 2 Regulations, I, William Holmes, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Hambantota District, do, by this Order—

- (1) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the First Schedule hereto, to be the maximum wholesale price per bag of 80 measures whole wheat above which whole wheat shall not be sold by wholesale at the places mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto,
- (2) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto, to be the maximum retail price per measure above which whole wheat shall not be sold by retail in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto,
- (3) direct that every trader who sells whole wheat in the places and in the areas mentioned in column 1 of the First and Second Schedules hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises (store or boutique) a notice in which shall be set out the maximum prices for whole wheat fixed by this Order,

- (4) direct that no person shall sell whole wheat which is adulterated with any other article,
- (5) direct that every person who sells whole wheat by wholesale or by retail shall on demand, give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- the date of sale,
  - the quantity of whole wheat sold,
  - the price paid for the quantity of whole wheat sold, and
  - the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail,
- (6) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
- any sale of any quantity of whole wheat for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale,
  - any sale of any quantity of whole wheat for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail, and
  - "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart, dry measure
