BY virtue of the powers vosted in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No 2) Regulations, I, Ceduc Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order-

- (1) revoke with effect from this date my Orders on soaps (locally manufactured)-----
 - (a) dated March 24, 1943, published in Government Gazette No 9,103 of March 26, 1943, in so far as it relates to
 - (a) dated Match 24, 1940, published in respect of Maya toilet soap,
 (b) dated August 3, 1943, published in Government Gazette No 9,154 of August 6, 1943, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed in respect of Mikado soap, (c) dated November 13, 1943, published in *Government Gazette* No 9,201 of August 6, 1943,

(u) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3, and 4 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the manufacturer's

- maximum price to a wholesale dealer per case, the maximum wholesale price per case and the maximum retail price per tablet or bar, as the case may be, above which soap of the description and grade specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold by wholesale or by retail, as the case may be, in any part of Ceylon,
- (in) direct that for the purpose of this Order-
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of any article specified in column (1) of the Schedule hereto for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale,
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of any article specified in column (1) of the Schedule hereto for the purpose of
 - (c) 'manufacturer' shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
 (c) 'manufacturer' shall mean any person or firm or association of persons who manufactures any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto,
 (d) a ''wholesale dealer'' shall mean any person who has been in the habit of selling for resale any article in control or firm or association of persons who manufactures any article specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto.

 - specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, (c) "manufacturer's maximum price" shall apply to any sale by wholesale by a manufacturer to a wholesale déalor,
 - maximum wholesale price " shall apply to all sales by wholesale except sales by a manufacturer to a (f)wholesale dealer,
 - (g) "maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail,
- (1v) direct that every trader who at any premises in Ceylon sells soap of any description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of soap of that description and grade,

(v) direct that every person who sells soap of the description and grade mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchaser of that soap a receipt, on demand, in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the date of the sale ,
 (b) the quantity of soap sold ,
- (c) the description and grade of soap sold,
- (d) the price paid for the quantity of soap sold, and
- (e) the nature of transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail,

(v1) direct that every trader who has at any time during the three months prior to this date sold any article mentioned in the Schedule hereto and has for the time being no stocks of that article available for sale shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises a notice to the effect that stocks of that article are not available for sale for the time being
