THE REVENUE PROTECTION ORDINANCE

Order under Section 2

WHEREAS I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, have during the present session of the State Council approved of the introduction into the State Council of a resolution whereby if such resolution be carried, the import duty payable on the goods specified in column I of the Schedule hereto shall be altered

Now therefore, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by section 2 of the Revenue Protection Ordinance, (Chapter 191), I do hereby order the Principal Collector of Customs from midnight of 27th/28th September, 1943, to demand and levy on the goods specified in column I of the Schedule hereto the corresponding Import duties severally set out in column III of that Schedule

Provided that Import duty at the corresponding preferential rates, if any, severally described in column II of the Schedule shall be levied and paid on such of the aforesaid goods as are proved to the satisfaction of the Principal Collector of Customs to have been produced or manufactured in and to have been consigned from the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the Dominions, India, Burma, the territories administered by His Majesty's Governments in the Dominions under mandate or otherwise, the British Colonies, the British Protectorates and Protected States or the Mandated Territories of Tanganyika, the Cameroons under British Mandate and Togoland under British Mandate
