PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency SIR ANDREW CALDLCOTT, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Samt Michael and Saint George, Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor in and over the Island of Ceylon with the Territorics and Dependencies thereof

# A CALDECOTT

KNOW Ye that in pursuance of the provisions of Article 74" of the Ceylon (State Council) Order in Council, 1931, I, Andrew Caldécott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Proclamation signify the assent given by His Majesty the King, through one of His Principal Secretaries of State, to the Bill intituled "An Ordinance to amend the Bank of Ceylon Ordinance, No 53 of 1938 ", which was passed by the State Council on the Eighteenth day of November, One thousand Nine hundred and Forty three, and was reserved by me under Article 77 of the aforesaid Order in Council for the signification of His Majesty's pleasure

Given at Colombo, in the Island of Ceylon this Fourth day of December, One thousand Nine hundred and Forty three

M L A -A 826 THE URBAN COUNCILS ORDINANCE, NO 61 OF 1939

Order under sections 21 and 30 BY vutue of the powers vested in me by sections 21 and 30 of the Urban Councils Ordinanco, No 61 of 1939, 1, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Order-

- (1) revoke, subject to the provisions of paragraph (4), the order relating to the number of members of the Bandarawela Urban Council and to the number and limits of the electoral divisions of the town of Bandarawela, published in Gazette No 8 630 of July 5, 1940,
- (2) order under section 30 that, subject to the provisions of paragraph (4), the Bandarawela Urban Council shall consist of soven members und the town of Bandarawela shall be divided into seven electoral divisions with the limits defined in the Schedule hereto, (3) order under section 21 that, for the purposes of the
- general election of the members of the Bandarawela Urban Council to be held next after the date hereof and of the purposes of the application of the provisions of the aforesaid Ordinance in any matter relating or

incidental to or connected with that election, the Order set out in paragraph (2) shall be deemed to be operative on any day, pilor to the day specified in paragraph (4), on which it may be necessary that that older should be so operative, and clare that the provisions of paragraphs (1) and (2)

 (4) declare that the provisions of paragraphs (1) and (2) shall come into effect on the day immediately following the date of expiration of the term of office of the members of the Bandarawela Urban Council who are in office at the date hereof
