BICYCLES

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No 39 OF 1939

Order

BY VIRTUE of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance No 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No 2) Regulations I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do by this Order,—

(i) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail-price above which bicycles of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon,

(ii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—

- (a) any sale for the purpose of use of bicycles mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
- (b) retail prices shall apply to sales by retail,

(iii) direct that every person who sells any of the bicycles specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall give to every purchaser of such bicycles on demand a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the quantity and description of the bicycles sold,
- (b) the price paid, and
- (c) the date and place of sale,

(iv) direct that any trader, who, at any premises in Ceylon sells any bicycles of the description specified in the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of bicycles of that description,

(v) direct that every trader who has at any time during the three months prior to this date sold any bicycles mentioned in the Schedule hereto and has for the time being no stocks of bicycles available for sale shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises a notice to the effect that stocks of bicycles are not available for sale for the time being,

(vi) direct that every trader in bicycles mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall furnish to me on or before September 17, 1943, a return stating—

- (a) the address of every premises in which are contained stocks of bicycles specified in the Schedule hereto, in his possession or under his control, and
(b) the quantity of such bicycles in each store
