THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No 39 OF 1939

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph 2 of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No 2) Regulations, I, Arthur Courtney Richards, Deputy Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from this date my Order on paper dated March 15, 1943, published in *Government Gazette* No 9,098 of March 15, 1943, in so far as it relates to the maximum prices fixed in respect of printed or waste paper used for wrapping,
- (ii) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale and retail prices, above which printed or waste paper used for wrapping shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon,
- (iii) direct that clauses (iii) to (vi) of my Order dated March 15, 1943, in respect of paper published in *Government Gazette* No 9,098 of March 15, 1943, shall apply to this Order as though those clauses were herein incorporated

CHILLY POWDER AND CURRY POWDER

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No 39 OF 1939

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939 as amended by Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No 2) Regulations, I, William Holmes, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Hambantota District do, by this Order—

- (1) fix the price, which is for the time being fixed by Order of the Controller of Prices as the maximum retail price per pound above which chilly powder and curry powder of the description and grade mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule thereto shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo, increased by the amount specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto, to be the maximum retail price per

pound above which curry powder and chilly powder of that description and grade shall not be sold within the limits of the Revenue District of Hambantota,

(ii) direct that for the purpose of this Order—

(a) any sale of any quantity of chilly powder and curry powder for the purpose of resale or any sale of chilly powder and curry powder in a quantity of one hundredweight or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale,

(b) any sale of any quantity less than one hundred weight of chilly powder and curry powder for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,

(c) "maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail,

(iii) direct that for the purpose of this Order "curry powder" shall mean any mixture containing any two or more of the following curyrstuffs in powdered form —

Chillies, coriander, pepper, cumin seed, fennel seed, mathe seed, turmeric, cinnamon, cloves, cardamoms, nutmeg, and salt,

(iv) direct that no person shall sell any powdered chillies mixed with any article or articles other than one or more of the following —

Coriander, pepper, cumin seed, fennel seed, mathe seed, turmeric, cinnamon, cloves, cardamoms, nutmeg, and salt,

(v) direct that no person shall sell any powdered chillies mixed with any article or articles as allowed by clause (iv) above unless the mixture contains not less than 20 per cent of powdered chillies by weight,

(vi) direct that no person shall sell any curry powder containing any article or articles other than those specified in clause (iii) above,

(vii) direct that no person shall sell any curry powder made by the India Condiment Co for the Government of Ceylon except in unopened one pound packets bearing the following marks —

Curry Powder
Specially prepared for
the Government of Ceylon
by
India Condiment Co,
Madras
1 lb nett

(viii) direct that any trader who, at any premises within the limits of the Revenue District of Hambantota, sells chilly powder and curry powder of the description and grade mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at these premises a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order in respect of chilly powder and curry powder of that description and grade,

(ix) direct that every person who sells by retail any article of the description mentioned in the Schedule hereto shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out —

(a) the date of sale,

(b) the quantity sold (by weight),

(c) the description of the article sold (specifying whether it contains chilly powder or not), and

(d) the price paid for the quantity sold,
