BY viitue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order-

(1) revoke with effect from this date Older dated July 19, 1943, published in Government Gazette No 9,150 of July 23, 1943, m so far as it relates to the maximum price fixed in respect of Coty Talcum Powder,

(11) fix the price specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto, to be the maximum retail price above which Coty Talcum Powder of the description specified m column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold in Ceylon,

(m) direct that for the purpose of this Order, any sale for the purpose of use of any quantity of any Coty Talcum Powder shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,

- (iv) direct that every person who sells Coty Talcum Powder specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall give to every purchaser of such Coty Talcum Powder, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out-
  - (a) the description and quantity of the Coty Talcum Powder sold,
  - (b) the price paid, and (c) the date and place of the sale

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No 39 of 1939

## Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices (Food) by section 3 (read with section 2 (3)) of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as amended by Defence Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No 2) Regula tions, I, Benjamin Franklin Petera, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), Kegalla District, do, by this Order —

- (1) revoke with effect from this date my Order fixing the maximum retail prices of curry stuffs, dated November 30, 1942, published in Government Gazette No 9,045 of December 4, 1942, in so far as it relates to the maximum retail prices fixed for dried chillies and red onions.
- (u) fix the price specified in any order for the time being in force, made by the Controller of Prices by section 3

of the Control of Prices Ordinance, as the maximum

retail price above which the articles of the description and grade mentioned in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto, shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of Colombo increased by the amounts specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto as the maxi mum retail price above which the articles of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto,

(iii) direct that the provisions of paragraphs 3 to 7 of my Order issued in respect of currystuffs dated Nov ember 30, 1942, published in Government Gazette No 9,045 of December 4, 1942, shall apply to this Order as though they were herein embodied

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, NO 39 OF 1943

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order-

- (1) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be respectively the maximum wholesale price and the maximum retail price above which drugs of the description specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon,
- (u) direct that every person, who at any premises in Ceylon sells any drugs of the description, specified in column
   I of the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises, a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in respect of the drugs of that description,
- (111) direct that any person, who at any premises deals or has at any time during the three months prior to this date dealt in any of the drugs of the description mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto and has for the time being no stocks of such drugs available for sale, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises a notice to the effect that he has no stocks available for sale for the time being.
- (iv ) direct that no person shall sell any of the drugs of the description mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any other article or with drugs of an inferior description or grade or quality.
- (v) direct that every person whether carrying on business as an importer or dealer in diugs or not who has m his possession a stock of any of the drugs of the description mentioned in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall furnish to the Director of Medical and Samtary Services, Colombo, within three days of publication of this Order in the Government Gazette, a return stating-
  - (a) the address of every premises in which are contained any of these drugs in his possession or under his control,
  - (b) the quantity and description of drugs m each
- (vi) direct that every person who sells any drugs of the description specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall give to every purchaser of that drug on demand a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of sale;
  - (b) the description of the drug sold,
  - (c) the quantity of drugs sold, and
  - (d) the price paid
