THE FOOD CONTROL ORDINANCE.

Order No. 26.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 (1) (d) of the Food Control Ordinance (Chapter 132), I, George Claude Stanley Corea, Minister for Labour, Industry and Commerce, do by this Order prohibit the removal from the Customs premises at any port or place mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto, of any rice or paddy which is imported into Ceylon, except under a permit issued by the person mentioned in the corresponding entry in the second column of that Schedule, and except in accordance with such directions as he may issue in regard to the time at-which, the manner directions as he may issue in regard to the time at which, the manner in which and the place to which such rice or paddy may be so removed.
