THE FOOD CONTROL ORDINANCE. Order No. 25.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 (1) (a) of the Food Control Ordinance (Chapter 132), I, George Claude Stanley Corea, Minister for Labour, Industry and Commerce, do by this Order prohibit the transport or removal of paddy or other grain from the areas specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto, except under the authority of a permit issued by the person mentioned in the corresponding entry in the second column of that Schedule.

THE FOOD CONTROL ORDINANCE.

Order No. 26.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 (1) (d) of the Food Control Ordinance (Chapter 132), I, George Claude Stanley Corea, Minister for Labour, Industry and Commerce, do by this Order prohibit the removal from the Customs premises at any port or place mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto, of any rice or paddy which is imported into Ceylon, except under a permit issued by the person mentioned in the corresponding entry in the second column of that Schedule, and except in accordance with such directions as he may issue in regard to the time at which, the manner in which and the place to which such rice or paddy may be so removed.

THE FOOD CONTROL ORDINANCE.

Order No. 28.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4 (1) (g) of the Food Control Ordinance (Chapter 132), I, George Claude Stanley Corea, Minister for Labour, Industry and Commerce, do by this Order direct the Food Controller to take steps for the allocation of supplies of rice, paddy and wheat to merchants and distributors in all parts of Ceylon other than the areas mentioned in the Schedule hereto, and to organize and administer a system of rationing such supplies on and after the date hereof.

THE FOOD CONTROL ORDINANCE.

Notice.

IT is hereby notified in terms of Regulation 4 (1) of Part III of Head E of the Food Control Regulations, 1938, read with Regulation 3 (1) of the Defence (Rice Rationing) (Issue of Substitutes) Regulation, that from the 3rd day of August, 1942, until further notice—

- (a) the weekly ration of rice which may be sold for consumption by any person who is over one year of age and is resident in any area, whether urban or non-urban (other than an estate), in which rationing is in force and is the holder of a ration book of any description specified in column I. of the Schedule hereto shall be the quantity specified in the corresponding entry in column II. of that Schedule;
- (b) the quantity of paddy which may be sold, in lieu of such weekly ration of rice, to the holder of any such ration book by a distributor, if he is authorised by or on behalf of the Food Controller so to do, shall be the quantity specified in the corresponding entry in column III. of that Schedule; and
- (c) the quantity of wheat which may be sold, in lieu of such weekly ration of rice, to the holder of any such ration book by a distributor if he is authorised by or on behalf of the Food Controller so to do, shall be the quantity specified in the corresponding entry in column IV. of that Schedule.

THE FOOD CONTROL ORDINANCE.

Notice.

IT is hereby notified in terms of Regulation 5 of Part II. of Head E of the Food Control Regulations, 1938, read with Regulation 3 (1) of the Defence (Rice Rationing) (Issue of Substitutes) Regulations, that from the 3rd day of August, 1942, until further notice—

- (a) the weekly ration of rice which may be sold or issued by way of sale or otherwise, to any person of any class specified in column I. of the Schedule hereto who is over one year of age and who is resident on an estate as defined in the Food Control Regulations, 1938, shall be the quantity specified in the corresponding entry in column II. of that Schedule;
- (b) the quantity of paddy which may be sold or issued by way of sale or otherwise, in lieu of such weekly ration of rice to any such person of any such class by a distributor, if he is authorised by or on behalf of the Food Controller so to do, shall be the quantity specified in the corresponding entry in column III. of that Schedule; and
- (c) the quantity of wheat which may be sold or issued by way of sale or otherwise, in lieu of such weekly ration of rice, to any such person of any such class by a distributor, if he is authorised by or on behalf of the Food Controller so to do, shall be the quantity specified in the corresponding entry in column IV. of that Schedule.
