THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

DEFENCE Regulation made by the Governor by virtue of the powers vested in him by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, of the Imperial Parliament, as adapted, modified and extended to Ceylon by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940.

*Regulation.*

The Defence (Control of Cafés) Regulations, 1942, published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 8,989 of August 18, 1942, are hereby amended, in regulation 5 of those Regulations, by the substitution, for the words "or any health officer", of the words "or any medical officer holding a commission in His Majesty's forces, or any health officer".
