**2½" BLACK BUTTWELD STEAM TUBES WITH  
BRITISH STANDARD THREADS AND COUPLINGS.**  
THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

*Order.*

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, Cedric Francis Ingledow, Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles), do, by this Order—

- (i.) fix the prices specified in columns 2 and 3 of the Schedule hereto to be, respectively, the maximum wholesale prices and the maximum retail prices above which steam tubes of the description and size specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall not be sold in any part of Ceylon;
- (ii.) direct that every dealer, who at any premises in Ceylon sells steam tubes of the description and size specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises the maximum prices fixed by this Order for steam tubes of that description and size;
- (iii.) direct that for the purposes of this Order—
  - (a) any sale, for the purpose of resale, of any quantity of steam tubes specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
  - (b) any sale, for the purpose of use of any quantity of steam tubes specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (iv.) direct that every person, who sells steam tubes of the description and size specified in column 1 of the Schedule hereto, shall give to every purchaser of such steam tubes, on demand, a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the quantity, description and size of the steam tubes sold;
  - (b) the price paid; and
  - (c) the date of the sale.

**LOCALLY MADE BRICKS AND TILES.**

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

*Order.*

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Controller of Prices, by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, as amended by paragraph (2) of the Defence (Control of Prices) (Supplementary Provisions No. 2) Regulations, I, William Oswald Stevens, Deputy Controller of Prices, Galle District, do, by this Order—

- (i.) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the Schedule hereto to be maximum prices above which Bricks and Tiles of the description and size specified in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Schedule hereto shall not be sold at any place within the District of Galle;
- (ii.) direct that every person who sells any bricks or tiles of the description and size specified in the Schedule hereto shall give the purchasers of such bricks or tiles on demand a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the number of bricks or tiles sold,
  - (b) the price paid for the bricks or tiles sold,
  - (c) the description and size of bricks or tiles sold, and
  - (d) the date and place of sale.
