## Order.

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices by section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, I, Richard Henry David Manders, Deputy Controller of Prices, Matale District, do, by this Order—

(1) revoke with effect from this date my Orders—

- (a) dated August 15, 1942, published in *Government Gazette* No. 8,991 of August 21, 1942;
- (b) dated October 7, 1942, published in *Government Gazette* No. 9,022 of October 16, 1942;

relating to the prices of Currystuffs and Pulses;

(2) fix the price, which is for the time being fixed by Order of the Controller of Prices as the maximum wholesale price per candy or cwt., as the case may be, above which the articles of the description and grade specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of Colombo, increased by the amounts specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto, as the maximum wholesale price per candy or cwt., as the case may be, above which articles of that description and grade shall not be sold within the area mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of that Schedule;

(3) fix the price, which is for the time being fixed by the Order of the Controller of Prices as the maximum retail price per lb. or measure, as the case may be, above which the articles of the description and grade specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto shall not be sold within the Municipal limits of Colombo, increased by the amounts specified in column 3 of the Second Schedule hereto, as the maximum retail price per lb. or measure, as the case may be, above which articles of that description and grade shall not be sold in the area mentioned in the corresponding entry in column 1 of the Second Schedule;

(4) direct that for the purposes of this Order—

- (a) any sale of any quantity of any article for the purpose of resale or any sale of any article in a quantity of one hundredweight or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
- (b) any sale of any quantity less than one hundredweight of any article for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (c) a "wholesale dealer" shall mean any person who is in the habit of selling by wholesale any article mentioned in the First Schedule hereto;
- (d) "maximum wholesale price" shall apply to all sales by wholesale;
- (e) "maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail;

(5) direct that no trader shall sell any article of any description or grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any other article or with any article of an inferior description and grade or quality;

(6) direct that any trader who, at any premises within the limits of any area mentioned in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, sells any article of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises, a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order of that article of that description and grade;

(7) direct that every person who sells by wholesale any article of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto shall, and every person who sells by retail any article of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the date of the sale;
- (b) the description and grade of the article sold;
- (c) the weight of the quantity sold;
- (d) the price paid for the quantity sold;
- (e) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or retail.

- (b) any sale of any quantity less than 200 lb. of any article for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
- (c) a "wholesale dealer" shall mean any person who is in the habit of selling by wholesale any article mentioned in the First Schedule hereto;
- (d) "maximum wholesale price" shall apply to all sales by wholesale;
- (e) "maximum retail price" shall apply to all sales by retail;
- (5) direct that no trader shall sell any article of any description or grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any article or with any article of an inferior description and grade or quality;
- (6) direct that any trader who, at any premises within the limits of any area mentioned in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, sells any article of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises, a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order of that article of that description and grade;
- (7) direct that every person who sells by wholesale any article of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto shall, and every person who sells by retail any article of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- (a) the date of the sale;
- (b) the description and grade of the article sold;
- (c) the weight of the quantity sold, if sold by wholesale, and the volume in measures of the quantity sold, if sold by retail;
- (d) the price paid for the quantity sold;
- (e) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (8) direct that every wholesale dealer in any article specified in the Third Schedule hereto, who has his place of business or store within the limits of any area mentioned in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto, shall furnish to the Controller of Prices, 111, Dam street, Colombo, on or before November 10, 1942, a return (sent separately in respect of each store), which shall specify—

## THE CONTROL OF PRICES ORDINANCE, No. 39 OF 1939.

*Order.*

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Deputy Controller of Prices by section 3, read with section 2 (3), of the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939, I, Chinnappah Coomaraswamy, Deputy Controller of Prices, Badulla District, do by this Order—

- (1) revoke with effect from this date my orders dated April 24, 1942, and dated September 25, 1942, published in *Government Gazettes* No. 8,930 of May 8, 1942, and 9,017 of October 2, 1942, respectively, in so far as they relate to the articles of the description and grade mentioned in the First Schedule hereto in respect of the areas mentioned in the Fourth Schedule hereto ;
- (2) fix the price, which is for the time being fixed by order of the Controller of Prices under section 3 of the Control of Prices Ordinance as the maximum retail price above which articles of the description and grade specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto shall not be sold by retail within the Municipal limits of the town of Colombo, increased by the amount specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto as the maximum retail price, above which articles of the description and grade specified in the corresponding entries in column 1 of that Schedule shall not be sold by retail within the areas mentioned in the Fourth Schedule hereto ;
- (3) direct that for the purposes of this Order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of any article for the purpose of resale or any sale of any article in a quantity of 200 lb. or more at a time shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale ;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity less than 200 lb. of any article for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail ;
  - (c) an " importer " shall mean any person who has cleared from the Customs in his name any article mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto ;
  - (d) a " wholesale dealer " shall mean any person who is in the habit of selling by wholesale any article mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto ;
  - (e) " maximum wholesale price " shall apply to all sales by wholesale except sales by an importer to a wholesale dealer ;
  - (f) " maximum retail price " shall apply to all sales by retail ;
- (4) direct that no trader shall sell any article of any description or grade mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto which is adulterated with any other article or with an article of an inferior description and grade or quality ;
- (5) direct that any trader who, at any premises within the areas mentioned in the Fourth Schedule hereto sells any article of the description and grade mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at those premises, a notice on which there shall be set out the maximum price fixed by this Order in respect of that article of that description and grade ;
- (6) direct that every person who sells by wholesale any article of the description and grade mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto shall, and every person who sells by retail any article of the description and grade mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto shall, on demand, give the purchaser of that article a receipt in which there shall be set out—
  - (a) the date of the sale ;
  - (b) the description and grade of the article sold ;
  - (c) the weight of the quantity sold if sold by wholesale and the volume in measures of the quantity sold if sold by retail ;
  - (d) the price paid for the quantity sold ;
  - (e) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail ;
- (7) direct that every importer of, and wholesale dealer in, any article specified in the Third Schedule hereto, who has his place of business or store within the areas mentioned in the Fourth Schedule hereto, shall furnish to the Controller of Prices, 111, Dam street, Colombo, on or before November 10, 1942, a return (sent separately in respect of each store), which shall specify—
  - (a) the address of the store ;
  - (b) the quantity of each article specified in the Third Schedule hereto which is contained in the store.

  - (c) the date of the sale; and
  - (d) the price paid for the article sold;
- (5) direct that every trader who has, at any time during the three months prior to this date, sold any article mentioned in the Schedule hereto, and has for the time being no stocks of that article available for sale, shall exhibit in a conspicuous position at his premises a notice to the effect that stocks of that article are not available for sale for the time being.
