PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir Andrew Caldecort, Knight
Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of
Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander
of the Most Excellent Order of the British
Empire, Governor in and over the Island
of Ceylon, with the Territories and
Dependencies thereof.

KNOW Ye that in pursuance of the provisions of Article 74 of the Ceylon (State Council) Order in Council, 1931, I, Andrew

Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Proclamation signify the assent given by His Majesty the King, through one of His Principal Secretaries of State, to the Bill intituled "An Ordinance to amend the Currency Ordinance, No. 21 of 1941", which was passed by the State Council on the Sixteenth day of November, One thousand Nine hundred and Fortythree, and was reserved by me under Article 77 of the aforesaid Order in Council for the signification of His Majesty's pleasure.

Given at Nuwara Eliya, in the Island of Ceylon, this Thirtieth day of January, One thousand Nine hundred and Forty-four.
