#### A PROCLAMATION.

A. CALDECOTT.

KNOW Ye that by virtue of the powers vested in me by section 5 (1) of the Cemeteries and Burials Ordinance (Chapter 181), I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Proclamation establish from the date hereof a general cemetery, to be called the Mulgampola General Cemetery, on the land described in Schedule A hereto for the burial or cremation of the dead within the limits specified and defined in Schedule B hereto.

And I do further, under section 5 (3) wholly exempt the general cemetery so established from the operation of section 10 of the Ordinance.

#### Schedule A.

Lots Nos. 1, 2 and 3 (V. O. T. P. 326395) in P. P. 6750.

Extent: 1 A. 1 R. 31.94 P. (Exclusive of the paths passing through the land).

Name of land: An allotment of land called Mulgampola, Kerakoppuwa and Kiriukkuwedagewatta.

Situation: Situated in Mulgampola within the Municipal limits of Kandy, in the Kandy District of the Central Province.

Boundaries:—

North by land described in T. P. 43518.

East by land described in T. P. 92223, land claimed by villagers and Crown land.

South by land claimed by villagers.

West by land described in T. P. 89780 and claimed by villagers.

THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASES ORDINANCE.

#### Notification.

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by regulation 1 of the regulations under sections 2 and 3 of the Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases Ordinance (Chapter 173), published in the *Supplement to Gazette* No. 7,481 of August 28, 1925, I, Andrew Caldecott, Governor of Ceylon, do by this Notification confirm the declaration of the "diseased locality" specified in the Schedule hereto, made by the Chairman of the Trincomalee Urban Council, the proper authority in that behalf, on January 28, 1944.

THE DEFENCE (MISCELLANEOUS) REGULATIONS.

ORDER made by the Governor under regulation 43D of the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations.

#### Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Controlled Articles (Bricks and Tiles) Order, 1944.

2. Each of the articles specified for the time being in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as a "scheduled article"), is hereby declared to be a controlled article within the meaning and for the purposes of regulation 43b of the Defence (Miscellaneous) Regulations.

3. (1) Every person who, on the date on which this Order is published in the *Gazette*, has in his possession or under his control a stock of any scheduled article shall, within ten days from that date, furnish to the Controller a return setting out—

- (a) the name and address and the place of business (if there is a place of business) of that person;
- (b) the nature and quantity of such stock;
- (c) the purposes for which such stock is kept; and
- (d) the situation of the premises in which such stock is kept or stored.

(2) Every person who, after the date on which this Order is published in the *Gazette*, imports any scheduled article shall, within three days from the date on which he takes delivery of that article, furnish to the Controller a return setting out the particulars specified in the foregoing sub-paragraph (1).

(3) Where two or more premises are used by any person for keeping or storing any scheduled article in his possession or under his control a separate return shall be furnished in respect of the stock kept in each such premises.

4. (1) Except under the authority of a permit, no person who is required by paragraph 3 to furnish a return shall—

- (a) appropriate to his own use any quantity of any scheduled article in his possession or under his control; or
- (b) remove or permit the removal of any quantity of any such article from the premises specified in such return.

(2) Except under the authority of a permit no authorised dealer (not being a person required by paragraph 3 (1) to furnish a return) shall—

- (a) appropriate to his own use any quantity of any scheduled article in his possession or under his control; or
- (b) remove or permit the removal of any quantity of any such article from the premises at which he carries on business.

(3) No permit under the preceding provisions of this paragraph shall be required for the purpose of authorising the removal of any quantity of any scheduled article which is sold or otherwise disposed of in accordance with the provisions of this Order.

5. (1) After such date as the Controller may specify by notification published in the *Gazette*, no person shall manufacture any scheduled article for sale or supply unless he is for the time being registered under this Order as a manufacturer.

(2) Every application for registration as a manufacturer shall be made to the Controller and shall specify the premises at which the applicant manufactures or proposes to manufacture any scheduled article.

(3) The Controller may in his discretion determine whether or not any person is to be registered as a manufacturer and shall issue to every person who is registered by him as a manufacturer a certificate to the effect that such person has been so registered.

(4) The Controller may cancel the registration of any person as a manufacturer if the Controller is satisfied, after such inquiry as he may deem necessary, that such person has contravened or failed to comply with any provision of this Order.

6. The Controller may in his discretion determine and notify in the *Gazette* the specifications to which any scheduled article manufactured in Ceylon must conform, and after the publication of any such notification, no manufacturer shall manufacture any scheduled article which is not in conformity with such specifications.

7. No importer or manufacturer or authorised dealer shall sell or otherwise dispose of any quantity of any scheduled article to any person unless that person is the holder of a general or special permit authorising him to purchase or otherwise acquire that quantity from that importer, manufacturer or dealer as the case may be, or otherwise than in accordance with such terms and conditions as may be specified in the permit.

8. No authorised dealer shall purchase or otherwise acquire any quantity of any scheduled article from any person other than an importer or a manufacturer.

9. Except under the authority of a permit, no person shall purchase or otherwise acquire any quantity of any scheduled article.

10. No person not being an importer, a manufacturer or an authorised dealer shall sell or supply any scheduled article to any other person.

Provided that the preceding provisions of this paragraph shall not be deemed to prohibit any person who has furnished a return under paragraph 3 (1) and who has not been appointed to be an authorised dealer from selling or disposing of the stock of any scheduled article specified in such return in accordance with such directions as may be given to him by the Controller.

11. (1) The Controller may in his discretion appoint such number of persons as he may deem necessary to be authorised dealers for the purpose of selling or supplying any scheduled article.

(2) The Controller may cancel the appointment of any person as an authorised dealer if the Controller is satisfied after such inquiry as he may deem necessary that such dealer has contravened or failed to comply with any provision of this Order.

12. Every application for a permit under this Order shall be made to the Controller in such form as may be prescribed by him by notification published in the *Gazette*.

13. (1) The Controller may in his discretion—

- (a) refuse to grant a permit under this Order to any applicant therefor;
- (b) determine and specify in any permit the terms and conditions subject to which such permit is granted;
- (c) alter, add to or rescind any of the terms and conditions of any permit;

(2) Every decision or determination of the Controller under the preceding sub-paragraph shall be final.

(3) Every person to whom a permit is granted under this Order shall comply with the terms and conditions specified in such permit.

14. No person to whom a permit is granted, under this Order shall—

- (a) transfer the permit to any other person; or
- (b) use the article obtained on such permit for any purpose other than the purpose specified in the application made in respect of that permit.

15. Every importer, every manufacturer and every authorised dealer shall—

- (a) keep and maintain in such form as may be approved by the Controller for the purpose such records or registers relating to his stock of scheduled articles as the Controller may by notice require him to maintain; and
- (b) furnish to the Controller such returns or other information relating to such stocks as the Controller may from time to time by notice require him to furnish.

16. Every return and every application made under this Order shall be verified by a declaration to the effect that the particulars contained therein are true and accurate.

17. The Controller or any officer authorised by him in writing may for the purpose of verifying the correctness of any information furnished or any record maintained by any importer, manufacturer or authorised dealer in pursuance of this Order or for the purpose of securing compliance with the provisions of this Order—

- (a) enter the premises at which such importer, manufacturer or dealer carries on business or keeps his stocks of any scheduled article;
- (b) inspect the stock of any scheduled article kept on the premises; or
- (c) inspect and take copies of any record, books or accounts kept by such importer, manufacturer or dealer (whether in pursuance of this Order or otherwise) in relation to his stock of scheduled articles.

18. The powers conferred on the Controller by this Order may be exercised on his behalf by any Deputy Controller or other officer acting under the general or special directions of the Controller.

19. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires—

- "Controller" means the Controller of Prices (Miscellaneous Articles) appointed under the Control of Prices Ordinance, No. 39 of 1939;
- "importer" means any person who imports any scheduled article into Ceylon;
- "manufacturer" means a person registered as a manufacturer under this Order;
- "permit" means a permit issued by the Controller under this Order.
